Your Verse

Proverbs 4:14-15 - "Do not set foot on the path of the wicked or walk in the way of evildoers."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 1:1 "Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take."
- Jeremiah 6:16 "Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths... and walk in them, and you will find rest for your souls."







Devotional: Heeding God's Warning Against the Wicked Path

Understanding the pitfalls begins with clear recognition. In *Proverbs 4:14–15*, we receive a solemn warning not to engage with the path of the wicked. This instruction is not merely physical but spiritual — a directive to avoid lifestyles and choices that distance us from God's will. Such paths are alluring yet destructive, often leading to regret and separation from God.

The Psalmist expands on this by describing the blessing of not walking with the wicked. Choosing wisely means actively rejecting influences that draw us into sin. *Jeremiah 6:16* encourages us to seek the "ancient paths," God's ordained way, where true rest is found. The crossroads represent moments in life where decisions define our direction.

Today, reflect on areas where you might be tempted to compromise wisdom. Are there influences or habits that steer you off the path of righteousness? Pray for discernment and courage to say no to any step that could lead to spiritual harm.

Devotional: Growing in Wisdom Illuminates Our Path

Devotional: Protecting Your Heart Secures Your Life

The heart is the wellspring of life and the battleground for our choices. In *Proverbs 4:23*, we receive a powerful admonition to guard our hearts above all else because our actions, words, and attitudes flow from it. Foolish living often begins internally, with compromised desires or unchecked influences.

Jesus in *Matthew 15:18* teaches that what is in our hearts shapes our speech and behavior. Our internal condition cannot be ignored if we desire godly living. Moreover, *Philippians 4:7* offers reassurance that God's peace is a protective barrier, guarding our hearts and minds when we rest in Christ.

Guarding your heart involves intentionality—choosing God's will, meditating on His truth, and rejecting harmful thoughts and temptations. It's a lifelong commitment that requires spiritual vigilance and dependence on the Holy Spirit. Reflect today on what you are allowing into your heart and how you can safeguard it more effectively.
