Day 1: ① The Call to Watch and Pray

Devotional: Answering God's Call to Spiritual Vigilance

Being a watchman starts with a clear calling from God. Ezekiel reminds us that a watchman's role is not passive; it demands vigilance and action. We are responsible not only to be aware of the spiritual dangers around us but also to sound the alarm through prayer and intercession.

Devotional: Interceding Boldly for Your Family

One of the most urgent roles of a watchman is interceding for family. Ezekiel's vision shows God longing for someone to stand in the gap, to protect the people by their prayers and obedience. As men mature, their prayers become a powerful shield around their loved ones—guarding against spiritual attacks, guiding future generations, and securing God's blessings.

Standing in the gap means more than praying alone; it also means modeling faithfulness in word and deed. Joshua's declaration highlights the importance of intentional leadership in the home—to choose God daily, to lead by example, and to build spiritual walls that keep the family safe.

Reflect on your own family's spiritual health today. Where does prayer need to deepen? Which relationships need healing? Invite the Holy Spirit to help you become a faithful intercessor who builds up walls of faith, hope, and love.
