Day 3: Overcoming Fear in Witnessing

Devotional: Replacing Fear with God's Spirit

Fear can paralyze our witness and prevent us from sharing the Gospel message. Yet God has given us a spirit not of timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline. This divine empowerment is designed to replace fear with courage and compassion.

Feeling afraid is natural. Many of the early disciples faced persecution and threats, yet they chose to proclaim Christ boldly because they trusted God's presence and purpose. Like them, we can overcome fear by focusing on God's promises and His sustaining power.

When fear creeps in, remind yourself that God is with you, and His perfect love casts out all fear. Pray for courage and maintain a daily dependence on Him. Often, stepping out despite fear opens doors for God's glory to shine through your witness.

Devotional: Witnessing Through God's Love

Effective witnessing flows from a heart aligned with God's love. God's love for the world is vast and sacrificial. He sent His Son so that everyone could have the chance to be saved. Understanding that God loves all people deeply shapes how we approach evangelism—with compassion, patience, and respect.

When we see others through God's eyes, our motivation changes. We move from judgment or pressure to sincere care for their eternal well-being. This perspective also guards us from discouragement when people reject our message because our goal is to plant seeds of faith, leaving the results to God.

Let love guide your witness. Pray for hearts to soften and eyes to open. Ask God to help you see everyone as He does—a loved creation with infinite worth.

Devotional: The Power of Listening in Evangelism
