Devotional: Harness Strength by Capturing Your Thoughts

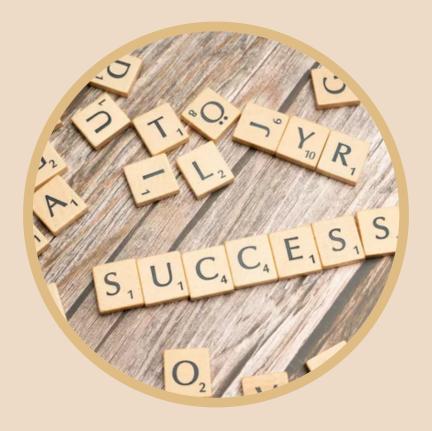

Devotional: Let God's Joy Strengthen Your Spirit

3.	Reflect on how joy affects your approach to success and setbacks.







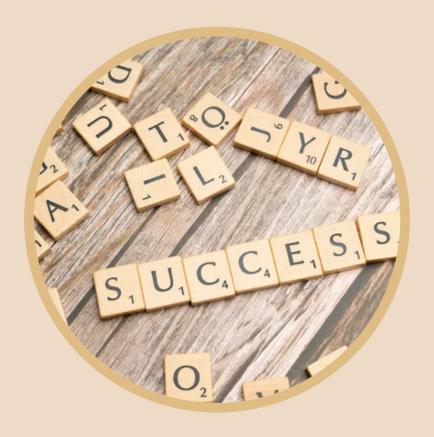
Prayer for Today

Devotional: Choose Words That Build Up and Encourage

Words have incredible power to shape mindset and reality. Proverbs 18:21 teaches that our tongues can build up or tear down. For a success mindset rooted in God's positivity, speaking life over yourself and situations is vital.

Negative self-talk can erode confidence and hope, while encouraging words strengthen faith and resilience. Ephesians 4:29 reminds us to speak only what benefits others and builds them up. This discipline applies to how we talk to ourselves too.

Today, become conscious of your words and vows. Speak affirmations of God's promises and your identity in Christ. Replace criticism and complaints with praise and hope. Your words can plant seeds of success or failure—choose life-giving speech.

Devotional: Replace Fear with God's Spirit of Power

Fear can cripple progress, rob hope, and paralyze efforts toward success. Yet, **2 Timothy 1:7** assures us God gifts us with a spirit of power, love, and self-control—not fear.

Faith is the foundation that breaks the chains of fear. When fear tries to sneak in, remind yourself of God's promises in Isaiah 41:10 and Psalm 27:1 that He is always with you and your protector. Confidence rooted in God allows you to face uncertainty boldly.

Embrace God's power today and intentionally reject fear. Let faith be the lens through which you see difficult circumstances, and respond with courage and peace.

Devotional: Trust God's Unfailing Promises Daily

Trusting in God's promises anchors our mindset in certainty rather than doubt. **Joshua 21:45** affirms that every good promise God made was fulfilled. This truth gives us hope and confidence that God will fulfill His purposes in our lives too.

When storms come, we can lean on His promises as unmovable ground. Psalm 119:50 shows how promises bring comfort amid suffering. As believers, we are heirs to precious promises (2 Peter 1:4) that strengthen and encourage us.

Reflect today on God's promises that resonate with your journey. Let these promises build your success mindset, reminding you that God's faithfulness never fails.
