Devotional: Obedience: The Hallmark of Wisdom

Jesus emphasizes the vital importance of both hearing and doing His words.

This is the starting point of building on the solid rock. It's not enough to be familiar with Scripture or to admire Jesus from a distance; instead, we must actively put His teachings into practice. The wise builder listens carefully and then acts.

Devotional: Jesus: Our Refuge in Every Storm

Storms are inevitable in life—but with Jesus as our foundation, we are secure.

The imagery of rain, streams, and wind illustrates the hardships and difficulties that test our faith. When difficulties arise, it is our foundation that determines whether we stand or fall.

Many people build their lives on shifting sands—temporary comforts, successes, or worldly approval. Such sand foundations do not endure under pressure. However, grounding ourselves in Jesus, who is unchanging and faithful, equips us to face adversity with peace and confidence.

Reflect on the storms in your own life. How have you responded to them? When your faith is built on Christ, trials become opportunities for growth and deeper trust, not defeat. The storms reveal what our foundation truly is. Take comfort in God's promise to be your refuge and strength always, and lean into His presence amid every trial.
