#### Devotional: Wisdom: The Foundation of True Wealth

**Today's focus is on the foundation of wealth—wisdom.** Proverbs 24:3–4 presents the idea that a house does not just appear or stand strong by chance. It requires wisdom to build thoughtfully, understanding to keep it secure, and knowledge to fill it with treasures. What this means for us is deep: to create and maintain wealth, whether physical or spiritual, wisdom must be the cornerstone.

But why wisdom? Wisdom equips us to make prudent decisions, avoid pitfalls, and steward resources well. Without wisdom, riches can be squandered and lives become unstable. It also reminds us that wealth includes more than money—our relationships, character, and spiritual health are treasures built through godly insight.

Today, ask God for wisdom (James 1:5) to guide your plans and decisions. Reflect on whether your current foundation is strong and anchored in God's truth. Remember, true and lasting wealth starts with building wisely.

## Devotional: Understanding: The Strength for Stability

Proverbs reminds us that God generously provides knowledge and understanding when we ask (Proverbs 2:6).
