Day 1: The Wise and Foolish Builders

Matthew 7:24-27 NIV - "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock."

Devotional: Hearing and Doing God's Word

Jesus' parable of the wise and foolish builders revealed in Matthew 7:24-27 sets the tone for our study. The wise builder hears Jesus' words and puts them into action, establishing a strong foundation. In contrast, the foolish builder ignores this counsel, resulting in destruction when storms come.

Isaiah foretells Jesus as the precious cornerstone, confirming that He is the only sure foundation for our lives. Paul reinforces this truth, emphasizing that no other foundation can provide lasting security.

When you choose to build on Jesus, you embrace a foundation tested and proven through time. This choice transforms how you face adversity: with confidence, peace, and hope.

Devotional: Faith That Stands Firm in Trials

Knowing Jesus overcomes the world (John 16:33) assures us that storms do not have the final say. God's presence sustains and strengthens us, even when external circumstances challenge our faith.

What storms are you facing today? When pressures mount, remind yourself your foundation is stable and deep. Trust God's power to hold you steady and guide you through every trial.
