Day 3: Bessings

Devotional: Blessing Yourself and Others with God's Grace

Milestones are perfect moments to receive and extend God's blessings.

Numbers 6:24–26 offers a timeless blessing that invokes God's protection, grace, and peace upon us. By blessing ourselves and others during significant moments, we participate in God's loving work on earth.

Receiving God's blessings invites a posture of humility and gratitude. It reminds us that all good things are gifts from Him. Likewise, speaking blessings over others fosters encouragement and builds spiritual connection.

Take time to bless yourself using Scripture, and consider how you can bless friends and family celebrating alongside you. These acts turn celebrations into sacred exchanges where God's favor flows freely.

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 40:31 "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary."
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."







Devotional: Finding Power and Courage through Christ

Every milestone is a testimony of God's strength working in and through us. In Philippians 4:13, Paul reminds us that our ability to overcome challenges and reach goals comes from Christ's empowerment.

Recognizing our dependence on God's strength encourages humility and perseverance. When facing the uncertainties and pressures at milestones, remembering that Christ is our strength boosts confidence and calms fears.

Celebrate your victories knowing that God's power sustains you, especially in moments of weakness or doubt. Use prayer to ask for renewed strength and courage as you move forward into new stages with hope and boldness.

- John 15:11 "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete."







Devotional: Experiencing Deep Joy Rooted in God's Presence

Milestone celebrations naturally bring joy, but true and lasting joy comes from the Lord. Nehemiah 8:10 reminds us that this joy strengthens us, especially in both the highs and lows of life's journey.
