Psalm 8:2 – "Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger."

Devotional: The Power of Childlike Praise

Children's joyful praise is powerful and pleasing to God. Psalm 8 celebrates the praise that rises from the mouths of the youngest among us, showing that even their simple expressions of worship can silence enemies and honor God in mighty ways. Jesus Himself affirmed this when He acknowledged the praise of children welcoming Him (Matthew 21:16), highlighting how God delights in pure, heartfelt worship.

What makes children's worship so special? It's their authenticity and unashamed joy, often uninfluenced by worry or doubt. They teach us that worship is about sincere, heartfelt connection to God, not perfection or formality.

Devotional: Cultivating a Listening Heart

Samuel's story shows the importance of listening to God with a willing heart.

As a child, Samuel learned to hear God's voice and obey, setting a foundation for a life of faithful worship. Worship includes both speaking to God and listening to Him, cultivating a relationship characterized by intimacy and attentiveness.
