- Matthew 18:10 "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven."
- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."







Day 1: K God's Care for Every Child

Devotional: God's Nearness to the Brokenhearted

In moments when you feel lonely or hurt, it's comforting to know that God is especially close to your heart. Psalm 34:18 reminds us that God notices and draws near when we feel broken or crushed in spirit. Children, like adults, sometimes experience sadness, fear, or confusion, but God never leaves them alone in these feelings. His care is tender and attentive.

Jesus also tells us to value children and assures us that God's angels watch over them continually. This means God's presence is not distant or indifferent, but active and loving. Even if you feel overlooked or small, God sees you and cherishes you deeply.

Remember also the powerful promise in Isaiah. When you feel afraid or uncertain, God's reassuring presence is right there beside you. He invites you to lean on Him for strength and courage every day.

As you reflect today, take heart in knowing God is a loving Father who watches over every child—especially you.

- Ephesians 3:17-18 "So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith...and may have power to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ."







Devotional: Unfailing, Everlasting Love for You

You are deeply loved by God—not because of what you do, but because of who you are. Jeremiah 31:3 tells us that God's love for you is everlasting, never-ending, and His kindness towards you never fails. Sometimes it's easy to feel we need to earn love or be someone else to be accepted, but God's love is simple, pure, and unconditional.

Zephaniah encourages us with the image of God as a Mighty Warrior who not only protects but delights in you with great joy. This is a powerful truth—you are precious and deeply treasured by God, who finds joy in your very existence.

Paul, in Ephesians, prays that we might truly grasp the vastness and depth of Christ's love—it's wider and higher than anything we can imagine. That love never gives up on you or those around you, including children who may sometimes feel invisible or less important.

Today, let yourself feel embraced by God's everlasting love and kindness that never leaves or fails.

Your Verse

Matthew 18:3 - "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

Supporting Scriptures

- Mark 10:14 "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these."
- Luke 18:16 "But Jesus called the children to him and said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them."







Day 3: Faith Like a Child

Devotional: Embrace Trust and Openness in Faith

Jesus teaches us the value of childlike faith—pure, trusting, and open-hearted. In Matthew 18:3, He tells us that entering God's kingdom means embracing a heart like a child's. Children trust easily, rely on their caregivers, and welcome love without hesitation. This faith is an example for all ages.

The Gospels repeatedly show Jesus welcoming children and blessing them, making it clear that God honors simple and sincere faith. Mark and Luke highlight that the kingdom of God belongs to those who accept Him with the heartfelt trust of a child.

God invites you to approach Him without fear or doubt, just as children do when they run into the arms of their parents. This means you can come to God with questions, hopes, and even doubts—you don't have to have all the answers.

When you trust God with a childlike heart, you open yourself to experience His love and grace in powerful ways.

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."
- Isaiah 54:17 "No weapon forged against you will prevail."







Devotional: God's Powerful Protection Surrounds You

God promises powerful protection over your life—always watching and guarding you. Psalm 91 assures us that God commands His angels to guard us wherever we go. Even though life might sometimes feel scary or uncertain, God's protection surrounds you.

Paul reminds Timothy—and us—that God didn't give us a spirit of fear, but one full of power, love, and self-discipline. This means that through God's Spirit, you can face challenges bravely, knowing that you are empowered and loved.

Isaiah encourages you that no weapon or harm formed against you will succeed because God's protection is stronger than any trouble you might face. This does not mean troubles never come, but God's presence gives you confidence and peace.

Today, remember that God's protection, love, and strength are active in your life every moment.

2 Peter 3:18 – "But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

Supporting Scriptures

- Ephesians 4:15 "Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ."
- Colossians 1:10 "So that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work."







Devotional: Embrace Growth in God's Love and Truth

God desires that you grow every day in His grace and knowledge through Jesus. Just as children grow in height, strength, and skills, spiritual growth means learning more about God's love and showing it in your life.

Peter encourages us to grow in grace, which means receiving God's kindness and forgiveness, and to grow in knowledge of Jesus, understanding who He is and what He teaches. This growth helps us become more like Jesus—loving, kind, and wise.

Ephesians and Colossians remind us that spiritual growth happens when we speak truth with love and live in ways that please God by doing good works. These actions are fruits of a growing faith and show others the love of God.

Today, embrace opportunities to learn, love, and grow in God's grace, trusting He is with you every step.

Your Verse

Acts 1:8 - "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you."

Supporting Scriptures

- Galatians 5:22–23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."
- Romans 8:38–39 "Nothing...will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."







Day 6: 6 Filled with God's Spirit

Devotional: Live Boldly Filled with the Spirit

God gives His Holy Spirit to fill your heart with power and fruitfulness. In Acts, Jesus promises that when the Holy Spirit comes, you will receive power —not just for amazing miracles, but to live a life full of love, joy, peace, and other beautiful qualities.

Galatians describes these qualities as the fruit of the Spirit, showing how being close to God helps you become kind, gentle, faithful, and selfcontrolled. These qualities are signs God is working in your life and through you.

Romans shows us that nothing can separate you from God's love—not troubles, fears, or anything else. The Spirit's presence assures you of God's constant embrace and strength to keep going.

Today, invite the Holy Spirit to fill you afresh and help you live boldly in God's love and power.

- Psalm 23:4 "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me."

Devotional: Trusting God's Hopeful Plan for You

God has wonderful plans full of hope and a bright future just for you. Jeremiah 29:11 offers one of the most reassuring promises that God knows exactly what He is doing in your life and desires to bless you fully.

Romans adds that God fills us with joy and peace as we trust Him, even when life is hard. This peace is a wonderful gift, reminding us that we don't have to be anxious or fearful about the future.

Psalm 23 beautifully pictures God walking with us through difficult times, calming all our fears because He is always by our side.

As you conclude this study, hold fast to these promises and trust that God's love and hope are guiding your path today and always.
