Your Verse

Proverbs 2:1-5 - "My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you... then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God."

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault."
- Psalm 111:10 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding."







Devotional: Seek Wisdom Earnestly and Reverently

Why seek wisdom? Proverbs 2 begins with an earnest plea to treasure and actively pursue wisdom. The passage compares wisdom to hidden treasure that must be searched for with determination. Notice the conditions: accepting words, storing commands, and inclining the ear to wisdom. These actions reflect a heart posture that values God's guidance above all else.

Wisdom isn't just intellectual knowledge; it's a deep understanding rooted in the *fear of the Lord*. This reverent awe is foundational, not a source of fear but of profound respect and submission to God. Once we embrace this attitude, the path to understanding God's purpose for our lives becomes clearer.

Take a moment to consider your own pursuit of wisdom. Do you seek it daily in prayer and study? Are you storing God's commands in your heart, ready to apply them? This passage reminds us that the pursuit of wisdom leads to an intimate relationship with God and a transformed life.

Your Verse

Proverbs 2:12-22 - "Wisdom will save you from the ways of wicked men... that you may walk in the way of good men and keep to the paths of the righteous."

- Psalm 1:1–2 "Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked... but whose delight is in the law of the LORD."
- Jeremiah 6:16 "This is what the LORD says: 'Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths... then walk in them."







Devotional: Deliberate Choices Shape Our Destiny

The choice is clear. Proverbs 2 paints a vivid picture of the consequences that come from choosing to follow wisdom or to follow folly. Wisdom saves us from deceitful and evil influences, leading us on paths that honor God and bless our lives. Wise living results in security and peace, while foolishness leads to destruction.

This passage urges us to stand at life's crossroads and intentionally choose the path of righteousness. It is not always the popular or easy road, but it is the one that leads to true fulfillment and God's blessing.

Consider the influences in your life. Are they drawing you toward wisdom and good company or temptations and poor choices? Embracing wisdom requires vigilance and a heart tuned to God's voice above all others. While folly may appear attractive initially, its outcome is ultimately ruinous.

Today, commit to choosing wisdom. Trust that God's way is perfect and His paths lead to lasting joy. Walk boldly in His righteousness and encourage others to do the same.
