#### Devotional: Recognize Your God-Given Authority Today

On this first day, we establish the foundation of spiritual warfare: understanding the authority God has given you. Sometimes, when people move into a new home, they feel vulnerable to unseen spiritual influences. The truth is, as a believer, you have been given authority over these forces through Jesus Christ.

Luke 10:19 reminds us emphatically that Jesus has empowered us to "overcome all the power of the enemy." This isn't a suggestion—it's a promise based on Christ's victory on the cross. Your authority over evil spirits and darkness is real and powerful.

However, this authority is effective only as you consciously submit to God's will and actively resist the enemy, as James 4:7 points out. This means that the spiritual cleansing of your home begins with a heart posture of submission and trust in God's power.

Today, reflect on what it means to walk confidently not as a victim, but as a victor under Christ's authority. As you prepare to cleanse your home, remember: you are not powerless but empowered by the risen Savior.

# Devotional: Use Scripture as a Sword to Cleanse Your Home

Hebrews 4:12 speaks of God's Word as living and active—a sword that can cut away darkness and reveal truth. When you read scripture aloud in your home, you are in effect directing God's power to cleanse and establish holiness in your living spaces.

- James 4:8 "Come near to God and He will come near to you..."
- 1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us..."







Day 4: A Renouncing Past Spirits and Influences

#### Devotional: Break All Ties to Past Darkness

Before fully claiming your home, it's important to renounce any previous spiritual strongholds or influences that may linger. Whether the home was filled with negative spiritual activity or you fear inherited curses, take authority to break those chains now.

2 Corinthians 6:17 gives a clear instruction to separate yourself from unclean influences. This means confessing any agreement you might unknowingly have with darkness and declaring freedom through Christ.

James 4:8 encourages drawing close to God as you pull away from impurity. This dual movement—turning from evil and toward God—cleanses your heart and your environment.

Furthermore, 1 John 1:9 reminds you that God's forgiveness is ready and faithful when you confess. When you pray through cleansing prayers, confessing and renouncing, God's grace restores and protects your home.

Today, pray specifically to break ties with any past ungodly influences in your home and claim it entirely for the Lord.
