#### Devotional: God Calls You by Name: Stand Confident

Every journey begins with hearing your name called by the One who knows you intimately. **Isaiah 43:1** invites us to recognize that God has redeemed us and claims us as His own. When doubts attempt to silence your calling, remember that the Creator designed you with intentionality and purpose.

In those quiet moments of insecurity, it is vital to cling to the truth that God summoned you by name—not as an afterthought but by divine plan. The message from Jeremiah reminds us that even before birth, God had a destiny for us. This truth empowers women to counter negative self-talk by affirming our worth in God's eyes.

Take time to meditate on Psalm 139:14 and celebrate the unique beauty and gifts God has placed within you. Your calling is not based on how others define you but on how your Heavenly Father lovingly calls you forward.

#### Devotional: Courage to Embrace Your Divine Moment

Esther's story reminds us that God's timing and placement are intentional. Though faced with fear, she stepped into her calling boldly, recognizing the divine purpose before her. Esther 4:14 challenges each of us to consider that we are positioned by God for significant moments.

Fear and insecurity may seek to paralyze you, but God calls you to courage. Joshua 1:9 offers a powerful promise that God is with you, removing reasons for fear or discouragement. Likewise, 2 Timothy 1:7 reveals that God's Spirit empowers us with strength, love, and self-discipline—antidotes to timidity.

Today, ask God for courage to face doubts, and remember that He equips you for your unique path. Trust that your presence and your voice matter exactly where God has placed you.

#### Devotional: Saying Yes: The Power of Holy Surrender

Mary's affirmative response to God's unexpected calling is a beautiful example of complete surrender. Despite the uncertainties she faced, her heart trusted and yielded, saying, "May your word to me be fulfilled."

Surrender is the gateway to confidently walking in your God-given role, even when doubts arise. Proverbs 3:5-6 encourages placing full trust in God's wisdom beyond our own understanding. Trusting God releases us from the paralysis of our doubts and insecurities.

Romans 12:1 exhorts us to offer ourselves as living sacrifices, an act of worship that involves daily surrender of control. Like Mary, saying "yes" to God means accepting that His plan is perfect—even when the path is unclear.
