#### Your Verse

Joshua 1:9 - "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Deuteronomy 31:6 "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you."
- Psalm 27:1 "The LORD is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?"







#### Devotional: God's Promise Strengthens Our Courage

Beginning with a firm foundation is essential when understanding courage. Joshua 1:9 is a powerful reminder that courage is not a human achievement but a divine command reinforced by God's promise to be with us wherever we go.

Often, we equate courage with grand moments of heroism, but this verse invites us to embrace courage daily, knowing we are never alone. God's presence is the source of our strength and boldness, especially in small decisions where fear or doubt might creep in unnoticed.

Fear can paralyze even the smallest step, from confronting a difficult conversation to saying no when pressured. Yet, this passage reassures us that courage is available because *God is with us* in every circumstance — even the seemingly insignificant ones.

Reflecting on this truth empowers us to let go of fear and discouragement. Courage starts when we trust God's constant presence, building confidence that He will guide and protect us in all our decisions, big or small.

### Devotional: Faithfulness in Small Things Builds Courage

Courage is not reserved for monumental moments—it is cultivated in the choices we make every day. The apostle Paul's exhortation to stand firm and be courageous encourages believers to be vigilant and faithful in their walk with God.

Often, the most unnoticed acts prove our courage—like choosing integrity over convenience, kindness over criticism, or obedience over comfort. Luke 16:10 reminds us that faithfulness in little things earns greater trust from God; so too courage is strengthened through these daily acts.

Day 3: F Growing Courage Through Obedience

#### Devotional: Trust and Obedience Build Steadfast Courage

Obedience to God nurtures steadfast courage in our hearts. When we trust in the LORD fully, we lose the grip of fear even when facing uncertain or challenging news.

Psalm 112:7 beautifully portrays the heart of a courageous believer—one who is confident because their trust is anchored in God's character and promises. This courage grows as we submit to God's will and choose obedience consistently, even when understanding is partial.

Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us to lean into God's wisdom rather than our own insight, allowing Him to direct our small and big decisions. James 1:22 encourages action—courage blooms not from passive knowledge but from doing what God commands.

# Devotional: Boldness in Small Acts of Speaking and Doing

Courage often calls us to speak up or take action even when it feels risky. The early church prayed for boldness to proclaim God's word, showing that courage is a gift we actively seek and rely on God to provide.

Acts 4:29 reveals the believers' request for strength to face threats with fearless speech. While the scale of our challenges may vary, the principle remains: God equips His servants for courage in all moments.

Whether it's a kind word in a tense situation, standing for truth in a small group, or living out faith authentically, these acts require boldness fueled by the Spirit.

Proverbs 28:1 contrasts fear with righteous boldness, encouraging us to embody lion-like courage in everyday life. Ephesians 6:19 reminds us to seek prayer support for this courage, emphasizing dependence on God's power.

Reflection on these truths encourages us to trust God's enabling presence to act and speak boldly in the small opportunities presented daily.

- Isaiah 40:31 "But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."







#### Devotional: Patience and Courage in Waiting on God

Courage includes patience and trust in God's perfect timing. Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us that life unfolds in divine seasons, inviting believers to trust God even when answers or outcomes are delayed.

Sometimes small courageous decisions mean waiting faithfully, resisting the urge to rush ahead or succumb to anxiety. Romans 8:28 reassures us that God works all things for good, even when we cannot see the full picture.

Isaiah 40:31 promises renewed strength for those who hope in the LORD, encouraging us to persevere and trust as we wait for His guidance and provision.

Courage in small decisions extends to trusting God's timing with humility, patience, and hope. This trust strengthens faith and prepares our hearts for the opportunities and challenges ahead.
