#### Introduction

#### Devotional: Strength in God's Presence Over Fear

*Fear of the future often arises from feeling alone and uncertain.* But God's Word assures us we are never alone. Isaiah 41:10 reminds us of God's powerful presence that banishes fear. The future may be unknown, but God's presence is constant and sure.

As we face what lies ahead, we can choose to trust God's character over our feelings. Trusting God means believing that He is good, faithful, and in control—even when the path is unclear. It means turning to Him each time anxiety creeps in and handing over our worries.

Open your heart today to this truth: God is with you and will strengthen you to face whatever tomorrow brings.

#### Devotional: Faith Empowers Courage to Face Tomorrow

#### Devotional: God's Peace Overcomes Fear and Anxiety
