# Courage to Love Sacrificially



Explore how God's Word empowers us to love sacrificially with courage amid challenges and fears.





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#### Introduction

Welcome to this five-day study on *Courage to Love Sacrificially*. In a world that often promotes self-protection and personal gain, choosing to love others sacrificially requires boldness that goes beyond natural strength. It is not a timid, hesitant love, but a courageous act of the heart, inspired and enabled by God.

Whether you're seeking to step out in bolder love toward family, friends, enemies, or your community, this study will inspire and equip you. Get ready to open your heart, stretch your faith, and experience the joy and cost of courageous, sacrificial love.

John 15:13 – "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."

- 1 John 3:16 "This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us."
- Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."







#### Devotional: Jesus Shows Ultimate Sacrificial Love

**Jesus defines courageous love.** John 15:13 states it plainly: the highest form of love requires laying down your life. This is more than words — it's an action requiring the deepest courage, surrendering self-interest for the good of another. Jesus modeled this perfectly, willingly embracing the cross for our salvation, showing us that sacrificial love is bold and fearless.

Love like this is not easy. It demands that we face pain, rejection, and risks. But Jesus' example encourages us that God empowers us to love in this way. Our courage to love sacrificially grows as we abide in Him and rely on His strength.

As we embark on this study, ask yourself: Where is God calling me to be courageous in love today? How can I let Jesus' sacrificial love transform my heart and actions?

Day 2: V Overcoming Fear Through Love

#### Your Verse

1 John 4:18 - "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear..."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control."
- Psalm 27:1 "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?"







Day 2: **(**) Overcoming Fear Through Love

#### Devotional: Let Perfect Love Drive Out Fear

**Fear often stands in the way of sacrificial love.** Whether fear of rejection, failure, or loss, it can paralyze us from acting in love. Yet 1 John 4:18 assures us that when we allow God's perfect love to fill our hearts, fear cannot take root. Love expels fear by anchoring us in God's faithfulness, courage, and purpose.

God's Spirit empowers us with power, love, and self-control (2 Timothy 1:7). This means that sacrificial love is not based on our natural ability but on divine enabling. When fear threatens to stop us, we can choose to depend on God's love and power to move forward bravely.

Reflect on areas where fear has limited your love. Invite God's perfect love to cast out those fears and inspire you to act with boldness today.

Galatians 5:13 - "Serve one another humbly in love."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Philippians 2:3-4 "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves..."
- Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve..."







#### Devotional: Serve Others with Humble, Bold Love

Courageous love expresses itself in humble service. Galatians 5:13 calls us to serve one another with love, choosing others' needs above our comforts or preferences. This kind of love requires courage to set aside selfish desires and step into the messy, sometimes uncomfortable work of serving.

Jesus exemplified this servant's heart. Mark 10:45 reminds us that He came not to be served but to serve, even to the point of death. Loving sacrificially means embracing the same mindset overflowing with humility and willingness to act for others' good.

Think about ways you can actively and boldly serve those around you. Serving is a practical way to love courageously and tangibly. Let humility fuel your boldness to love.

Remove selfishness from my heart and fill me with a servant's spirit. Give me courage to serve even when it's difficult, knowing that serving others is a powerful expression of sacrificial love. *In Your name, Amen.*

Ephesians 4:32 - "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other... just as in Christ God forgave you."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Colossians 3:13 "Bear with each other and forgive one another... Forgive as the Lord forgave you."
- Luke 6:27–28 "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you..."







Day 4: 6 Love That Forgives Bravely

#### Devotional: Brave Forgiveness Reflects God's Love

Forgiveness requires immense courage because it confronts pain and offense head-on. Choosing to forgive mirror's God's own tremendous grace toward us. In Ephesians 4:32 and Colossians 3:13, we're commanded to forgive as Christ forgave, which means releasing bitterness and embracing compassion even when it's hard.

Forgiving sacrificially is a bold act of love, defying our natural inclinations to hold grudges or seek revenge. Luke 6 challenges us even further to love and bless our enemies, demonstrating that love empowered by courage can transform relationships and hearts.

Invite the Holy Spirit to help you forgive boldly today, trusting that He will provide the strength and grace you need.
