## Devotional: Faith Over Fear in Times of Waiting

**Delays breed uncertainty and fear**, but God's Word reminds us repeatedly not to be afraid. Isaiah 41:10 assures us that God is always with us. His presence is the source of our courage during difficult waiting seasons.

Waiting can be frustrating when we want immediate answers or action. However, God calls us to *strength and courage*, not because the waiting is easy, but because He sustains us through it. Courage isn't the absence of fear—it's trusting God despite fear.

Consider Joshua 1:9, where God commands strength and courage coupled with the promise of His constant presence. When delays come, lean on this truth: God is near, and His plans are good, even when the timeline is unclear.

Today, focus on anchoring your courage in God's nearness, allowing His peace to quiet your anxious heart.
