Devotional: Embracing God's Unchanging Truth

Jesus said knowing the truth brings freedom. This truth is rooted in God's Word, which shines light on our path and guides our decisions. Without truth, the rest of our armor cannot stand firm because we would be easily swayed by deceit or fear.

Today, reflect on your relationship with truth. Are you actively seeking God's truth in Scripture and life? Are there areas where you struggle to embrace uncomfortable spiritual realities? The belt of truth equips you to face challenges honestly and confidently.


