Even in the early church, angels directed Philip to critical mission opportunities, illustrating how God continues to use His messengers to advance His Kingdom.

These examples encourage us to be attentive to God's communication, whether directly or through His servants. They remind us to listen carefully and obediently when God calls or guides us, trusting His plans unfold with angelic assistance.

Angels also accomplish God's judgment and justice on earth. In 2 Samuel, the Lord's angel executes judgment but stops when David intercedes, showing both justice and mercy.

During the exodus, the angel of death passed over Israelite homes marked by faith, sparing them while judging Egypt.

Revelation describes angels sounding trumpets to unleash God's final judgments, emphasizing their role as executors of divine justice.

This powerful responsibility reminds us of God's righteous governance and calls us to live in holiness, trusting His perfect justice.

This teaches that angels are fully aware of earthly and spiritual events and faithfully report to God. Their observation calls us to live accountable lives under God's all-seeing eye.
