
# Discovering God's Love Through the Bible


As you journey through these 21 days, remember: God's love is not distant or conditional. It is vast, accessible, and offered freely – just for you.

#### Devotional: God's Love Is Personal and Sacrificial

One of the most cherished verses in the Bible, John 3:16, opens the door to understanding the depth of God's love. This was a gift given not because we earned it, but simply because He loves us.










## Day 2: God's Love Is Unfailing

Day 2: S God's Love Is Unfailing

#### Devotional: The Unfailing Nature of God's Love



Psalm 91 uses beautiful imagery to describe the protection God offers. Under His wings, we find true refuge and safety, not just physically but emotionally and spiritually.

Isaiah 54 emphasizes that even when everything around us is unstable, God's love never shakes or fails. It is our unchanging foundation in life's storms.



#### Devotional: Love that Changes Our Lives

God's love is not static; it actively transforms us from the inside out. 2 Corinthians 5:17 speaks of this transformation — through Christ, we become entirely new. The old self, with its sins and mistakes, is replaced by a new creation shaped by God's love.

Ephesians 2 reminds us that this new life is born from God's mercy and love, not from anything we have earned. This grace enables us to live with hope and purpose.

Titus 3 echoes this truth, emphasizing that salvation is a gift, motivated by God's mercy and love, not our own actions.

Consider how God's love has already changed you, or how it might do so if you open your heart to Him anew. His love invites you to walk in freedom, peace, and restoration.
