
# Discovering Jesus Through the Miracle of the Fish's Coin



Explore Jesus' teaching and provision in the fish's mouth story to deepen your faith and trust in God's care and obedience.





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#### Introduction

Welcome to this 7-day journey exploring the powerful lesson Jesus taught using the miracle of the fish with the coin in its mouth. Though a brief account found in *Matthew 17:24–27*, this story is rich with meaning about faith, obedience, provision, and God's sovereignty over all creation.

In the Gospel narrative, Jesus instructs Peter to catch a fish, inside which he finds a coin to pay the temple tax. At first glance, it seems like a simple miracle about meeting a financial obligation. Yet, it reveals deeper truths about Jesus' knowledge, authority, and care for His followers.

This study plan invites you to meditate on this passage and its surrounding context, helping you unravel the layers of Jesus' teaching. As you reflect on the fish's mouth and the coin, consider the significance of God's provision even in unexpected ways, and the call to follow Jesus' guidance diligently.

Each day, you will encounter Scripture passages, devotional thoughts, reflective questions, and prayer prompts designed to deepen your relationship with Christ. Whether you are new to the Bible or well versed, this plan encourages you to see God's hand at work in the everyday moments, trusting Jesus to provide what is needed, even when it seems unlikely.


Let us open our hearts to be taught and transformed by the Lord through this unique miracle story, embracing the lessons of faith, obedience, and divine provision.

















#### Your Verse

Matthew 17:24–27 – "Jesus said, '... go to the lake and throw out your line. Take the first fish you catch; open its mouth and you will find a four-drachma coin."

- Philippians 4:19 'And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.'
- Psalm 24:1 'The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it...'







#### Devotional: Jesus Provides in Unexpected Ways

This passage highlights Jesus' authority and provision in everyday matters.

The temple tax symbolizes obedience to religious duties, and Jesus demonstrates that He cares even about small financial obligations. By instructing Peter to catch a fish that will carry the coin needed, Jesus shows that God can provide in unexpected ways.

Notice Jesus' calm assurance and knowledge. He orchestrates the event before Peter acts, illustrating God's sovereignty over nature and circumstances. This encourages us to trust in God's provision regardless of our challenges.

When we face situations that test our faith—like financial stress, obligations, or uncertainty—we can reflect on this miracle and remember that God sees our needs and provides in His perfect timing.

Let this story remind you to rely on Jesus' guidance and expect His provision, even when it seems impossible.

- James 1:22 'Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.'







Day 2: V Trusting Jesus' Instructions

#### Devotional: Faith in Action through Obedience

Obedience to Jesus' instructions is central to this passage. Peter didn't know where the coin would be or why, but Jesus told him exactly what to do. Peter's step of faith and obedience resulted in provision.

Often, God's instructions may not be clear or easy to understand. Yet, trusting Jesus means following His word even in uncertainty. His directions can lead us to resources and solutions we hadn't anticipated.

This story reminds us that obedience moves faith into action, which opens doors for God's blessings. God often works through our willingness to obey in small, practical steps.

Today, ask yourself if you are ready to listen to Jesus' voice and obediently act, even when the outcome is not immediate or obvious.

#### Prayer for Today



Day 3: 1 Honoring God with Our Finances

Matthew 17:24 – 'When they came to Capernaum, the collectors of the two-drachma temple tax came to Peter...'

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Malachi 3:10 'Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse... and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven.'
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 'Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion.'







Day 3: 1 Honoring God with Our Finances

#### Devotional: Stewardship as an Act of Worship

The temple tax episode highlights the importance of honoring God with our money. Even Jesus, who is Lord of all, submitted to paying the tax to fulfill earthly responsibilities and respect divine institutions.

This act models humble obedience and respect for God's commands, including stewardship of finances. Honoring God includes using our resources responsibly, contributing to His work, and trusting Him with our finances.

Reflect on your relationship with money and how you honor God through it. Do you see your resources as blessings to manage or burdens? Jesus' example teaches us to engage in financial responsibilities with faith and integrity.

Consider how you can better align your finances with God's purpose, offering your gifts back to Him with joyful willingness.

# Devotional: Trusting God's Supreme Control

This miracle emphasizes God's lordship over all creation—even the fish in the sea. The fact that Jesus knew exactly which fish carried the coin shows His intimate sovereignty over nature.

Such sovereignty means that nothing happens outside God's control. This gives believers peace amid uncertainty, knowing that God orchestrates events for His glory and our good.

Reflect on how this truth impacts your faith during difficult or confusing seasons. God's creative power extends across every aspect of life, including the smallest details.

Adore God today for His wisdom and control over the universe, trusting that He wills and works for your blessing and His glory.

#### Devotional: Jesus Cares Deeply About You

Jesus' instruction to find the coin in the fish's mouth reveals His intimate knowledge of our needs. Just as God provides precisely what Peter needs to pay the tax, He also understands your needs completely.

We may sometimes feel overlooked or forgotten, but this passage reassures us that Jesus is aware of our circumstances. His care is personal and precise.

Jesus calls us to cast our anxieties on Him with confidence, knowing He cares enough to provide what we need exactly when we need it.

Let this truth comfort and encourage you today. Bring your needs to Jesus, who knows them better than you do.




















Day 7: 🎇 Living by Faith and Thanks
