## Introduction

**The Gospels** are the heart of the New Testament, presenting the life, message, and mission of Jesus Christ. Each Gospel writer—Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—offers a unique perspective on who Jesus is, His kingdom, and how His teachings call us to a life transformed by grace and truth. Central to these writings is the idea of *God's kingdom*—a realm that transcends earthly riches and invites us into a treasure more valuable than any possession.

One of the most vivid parables about the kingdom's worth is found in **Matthew 13:45–46**, the *Pearl of Great Price*. Jesus compares the kingdom of heaven to a merchant seeking fine pearls who, upon finding one of great value, sells everything to obtain it. This image powerfully illustrates what it means to prioritize God's kingdom above all else. It challenges us to evaluate our own hearts and ask: What do we truly treasure? What costs are we willing to pay to own the kingdom?

Over the next three days, we will journey through key Gospel passages that help us understand the nature of Jesus' kingdom, the radical call to forsake worldly attachments, and the joy of embracing a treasure that never fades. Through prayer, reflection, and Scripture, you will be encouraged to deepen your appreciation for the value of God's kingdom and examine how it shapes your daily life.

Let us open our hearts to the truth that *nothing in this world compares to the riches found in Christ*. As we explore these passages, may you be inspired to



live in the freedom and hope that comes from pursuing the eternal pearl that is God's kingdom.

## Devotional: The Supreme Value of God's Kingdom

**What makes the kingdom of heaven invaluable?** The parable of the pearl in Matthew 13:45–46 reveals a merchant searching for something rare and precious—fine pearls. Upon discovering one of great value, he sells all his possessions to buy it. This story illustrates that the kingdom of heaven surpasses all earthly wealth, deserving total commitment.

In our lives, we often chase temporary riches—money, status, comfort. Yet these fade or fail to satisfy. Paul echoes this in Philippians 3:8 when he calls knowing Christ the "surpassing worth" worth more than anything else. Our earthly possessions are fleeting; God's kingdom is eternal. The merchant's decision to sell everything is a metaphor for surrendering all that we hold dear to grasp God's kingdom fully.

Reflect on what "selling everything" means for you. Are there attachments or distractions keeping you from embracing the kingdom? God invites us to prioritize Him, promising that what we gain in Him will more than compensate for what we relinquish. When we treasure God's kingdom over worldly things, we experience real freedom and joy.

## Devotional: Surrendering All to Follow Jesus

**Following Jesus is a call to total surrender.** In Mark 10, Jesus challenges a rich man to give up his possessions to gain treasure in heaven. This radical call highlights that the kingdom requires more than surface-level faith; it demands that we lay down anything that can become an idol in our hearts.

Similarly, Luke 14:33 declares that discipleship means renouncing all worldly attachments. These Scriptures invite us to examine what entangles us—whether wealth, comfort, pride, or control—and to let go so that nothing prevents us from fully embracing God's kingdom.

Hebrews encourages believers to strip away everything that hinders spiritual growth. The challenge is personal and ongoing. What hinders you? What idols compete for your devotion? God's kingdom isn't about accumulating more but about surrendering all to gain more—more joy, peace, and eternal life.

Today, ask God to reveal what you need to release and empower you to trust Him fully. The reward of the kingdom far surpasses any sacrifice.

## Devotional: Aligning Heart and Treasure
