Devotional: Power Tempered by Love and Patience

True strength is not about dominating others but exercising self-control and kindness. Titus 3:2 directs us to be peaceable, considerate, and gentle toward everyone—qualities that require intentional discipline.

As men, embracing strength under control means rejecting harshness and hostility and choosing patience and kindness instead. This reflects the character of Christ who exemplified power expressed through love and humility.

Paul's letters highlight the importance of being gentle even in leadership roles. It is not weakness to be tender; it is strength to be patient and to carry love in our dealings.
