#### Devotional: Hope and Joy Through Faithful Prayer

#### Devotional: Finding Joy in Loving Commitment

#### Devotional: Boldness Brings Joyful Strength

Esther's bravery in facing peril teaches that joy and strength come from reliance on God's purpose, even in frightening circumstances. Her willingness to risk her life to save her people was empowered by her courage, prayer, and unshakable faith.

This story reminds us that God places us exactly where we need to be to make a difference, and embracing that calling with joy can transform fear into boldness.
