Devotional: Courage to Face Your Giants

Devotional: God's Wisdom Empowers Young Leaders

Samuel's story illustrates how God grants wisdom despite youthfulness.

- James 4:6 "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."







Devotional: Lead with Humble Strength
