Devotional: Singleness: A Gift and Calling from God

Supporting Scriptures

- *Romans 12:2 – "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind..."*
- *Psalms 139:14 – "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful..."*



Day 2:  Overcoming the Pressure to Marry

Devotional: Finding Freedom from the Pressure to Marry

One of the hardest pressures for singles is the expectation to marry, often from family, friends, and culture. But God calls us to seek His approval above all else. Paul reminds us in Galatians that pleasing man can conflict with serving Christ.

Society often judges singleness unfairly, but God's opinion is what truly matters. When we focus on God, we break free from the stress and insecurity caused by external expectations.

By renewing your mind through Scripture, you can combat feelings of inadequacy and embrace your God-given identity. Psalm 139 reminds us that we are wonderfully made – not incomplete or lesser because we are single.

As you face pressure, remember your worth is defined by God's love, not marital status. Freedom comes when you choose His approval over human approval.

Devotional: Learning to Be Content in God's Strength

Contentment is a challenge for many singles facing loneliness or longing. Paul's words in Philippians show a model of deep contentment regardless of circumstances, relying fully on Christ's strength.
