#### Devotional: Root Your Identity in Christ Alone

Understanding our identity in Christ is the foundation for living whole while single. The world often defines us by our relationship status, but Scripture calls us to anchor our worth and purpose in God's unchanging love. *Galatians 2:20* reminds us that our old self no longer defines us—Christ's life within us is what truly matters.

Your purpose is not limited by your singleness. Ephesians 2:10 reminds us that we were created for good works — a divine calling specific to each individual. Whether serving in your church, nurturing friendships, or sharing the Gospel, your singleness allows you the time and energy to be deeply involved in God's work.

Consider how you might embrace this season to develop your gifts and serve with passion. When you work or minister, do so with all your heart, as unto the Lord (Colossians 3:23). Your single life is a powerful platform for God's glory and your personal fulfillment.

Day 3: V Finding Contentment and Joy

#### Devotional: Discover Joy and Peace in God's Presence

Contentment in singleness can be challenging in a culture that often equates happiness with romantic partnership. However, Paul's words in *Philippians 4:11* offer powerful insight: contentment is learned and can exist regardless of circumstances.

The key to true joy and contentment is found in God's presence (Psalm 16:11). When we prioritize intimacy with God and cultivate godliness, we find a lasting satisfaction that the world cannot offer (1 Timothy 6:6). This joy is not dependent on external situations but flows from a heart anchored in Christ.

Take time today to ask God to replace any feelings of lack or loneliness with His peace and joy. Remember that your singleness is an opportunity to experience God's fullness more deeply and walk in freedom and gratitude.
