# Devotional: Love That Mirrors Christ's Sacrificial Heart

# Devotional: The Power of Empathetic Listening in Marriage

**True emotional presence requires intentional, empathetic listening.** Often, men want to fix problems quickly, but their wives sometimes simply need to be heard and understood first. James 1:19 reminds us to be "quick to listen, slow to speak."

Empathy allows you to enter your wife's world and validate her feelings without rushing to judgment or solutions. This builds trust and deepens intimacy, demonstrating that you value her heart as much as her voice.

Practice slowing down today when your wife speaks, focusing fully on her words and feelings. Resist the urge to interrupt or immediately offer advice. Instead, ask gentle questions and acknowledge her emotions.

# Devotional: Sharing Burdens and Emotions with Grace

Before we can connect emotionally as husbands, we need to understand emotions through God's perspective. Psalm 34:18 assures us that God draws near to broken hearts. He wants us to be tender and supportive, not dismissive or indifferent.

Acknowledge that emotions are a God-given way to communicate and connect deeply. When your wife expresses joy, sorrow, or frustration, God calls you to share in those emotions—to rejoice and mourn with her.

Today, ask God for sensitivity to recognize your wife's emotional landscape and courage to bear her burdens with love. When you do, you grow together in spiritual unity and emotional intimacy.
