#### Devotional: Divine Judgments Reveal God's Control

The opening of the seven seals reveals a sequence of judgments and events signaling the approaching end. As each seal breaks, John witnesses scenes of conquest, war, famine, and death. These are not random disasters but divine warnings that call humanity to reflection.

Often, we see parallels between these seals and modern crises like pandemics, war, and natural disasters. While frightening, these plagues reveal that God's justice is precise and purposeful.

Remember, the Lamb who opens the seals is Jesus — sovereign over all. His judgment is tempered with mercy, and He invites us to trust in His control despite turmoil around us.
