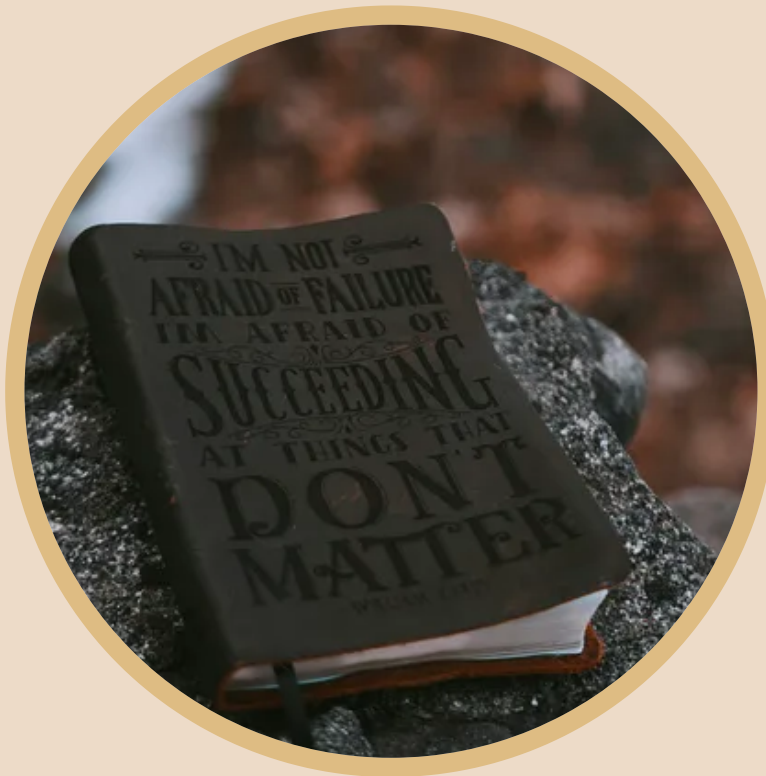
reflect on modern dreams, and equip you to discern the times with God's guidance and peace.

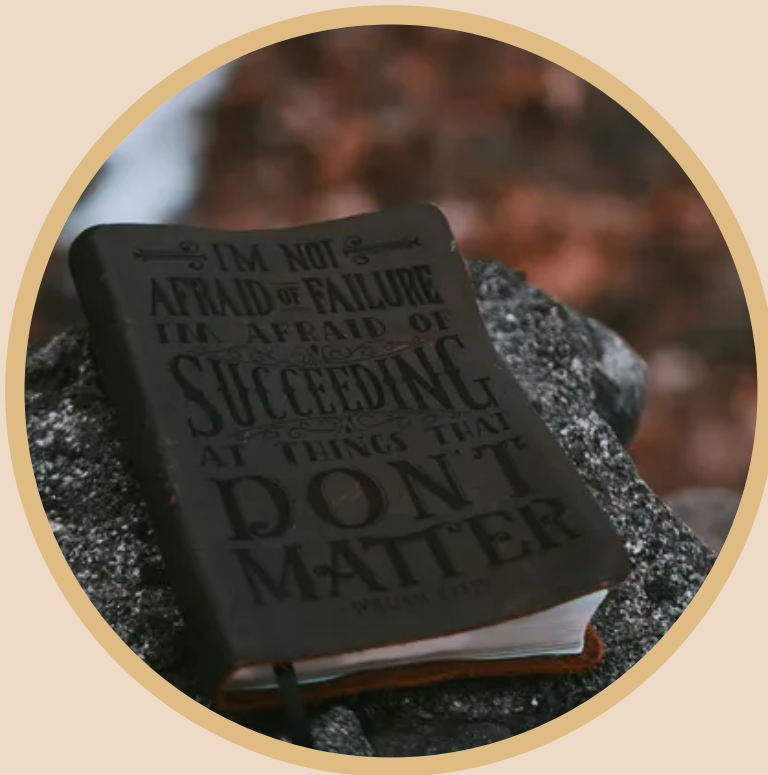
Prayer for Today

3. List Scriptures that help you evaluate teachings and dreams.



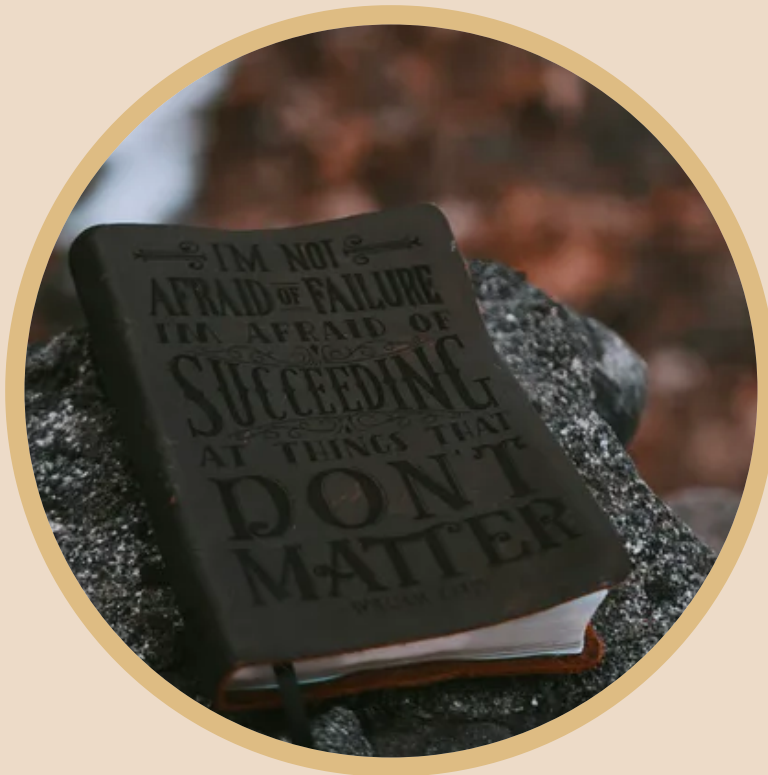
Prayer for Today

Day 5: 🛡️ Standing Firm Amidst Confusion

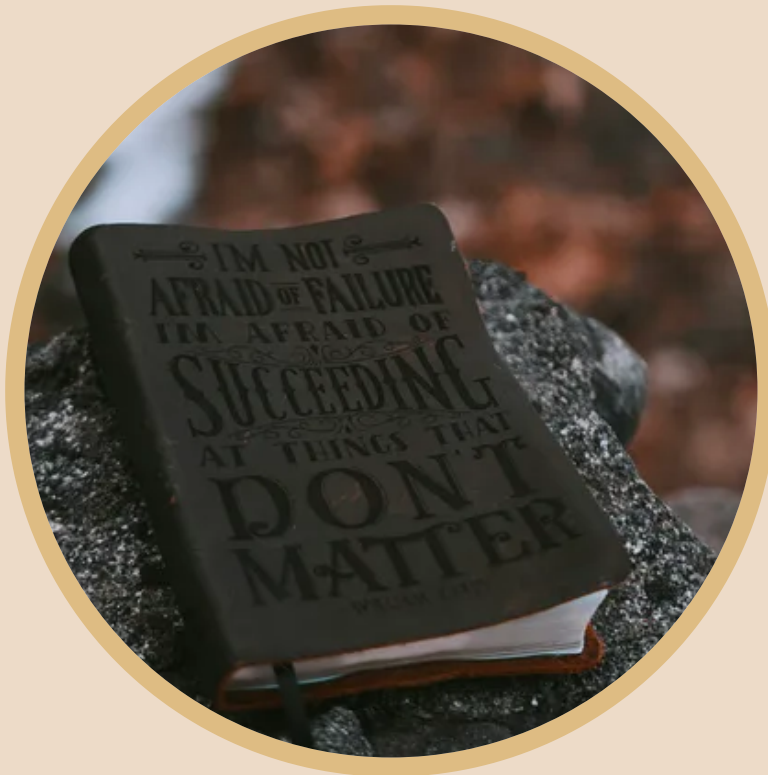
Prayer for Today

Day 6: ✨ Hope and Assurance in Prophecy

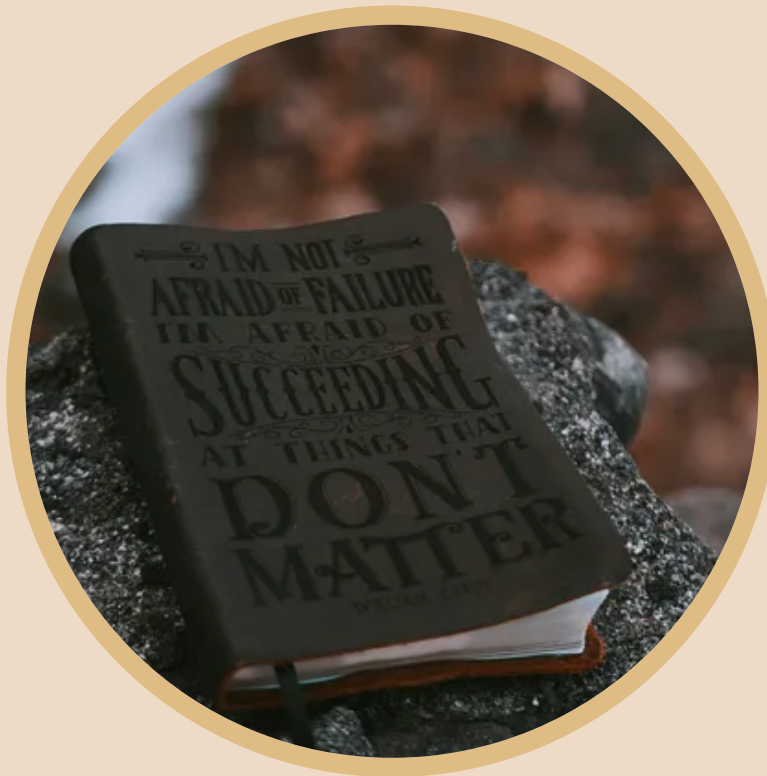
Prayer for Today
