# Devotional: Place Wholehearted Trust in God's Guidance

- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."







#### Devotional: Embrace Trials as Growth, Not Setbacks

Trials are not obstacles to endure but opportunities to grow stronger in faith. James encourages believers to consider difficulties as occasions for joy because these experiences develop perseverance, an essential quality for enduring major life decisions and challenges.

When your faith is tested, endurance grows, shaping your character and deepening your hope. Romans 5:3–5 outlines this spiritual progression — suffering leads to perseverance, which builds character, culminating in a hopeful outlook beyond natural circumstances.

In moments of weakness or doubt at the crossroads, remember that God's grace is abundant and sufficient. Paul's testimony in 2 Corinthians 12:9 reveals that God's power is most evident when we recognize our own limitations and depend fully on Him.

Allow trials to refine you rather than discourage you. Embrace the strength God provides to endure and emerge better equipped for His purposes.

# Devotional: Cultivate Hope and Strength While Waiting
