## Devotional: God's Purpose in the Refiner's Fire

#### Devotional: The Joy and Growth in Perseverance

Perseverance is the spiritual stamina developed through repeated testing.

The Bible encourages believers to 'consider it pure joy' when facing various trials because such moments develop endurance and maturity in faith.

This joy doesn't come from the hardship itself but from the knowledge that God is molding us through it. Perseverance produces essential qualities in us —strength of character and hope that anchors the soul.

Endurance is like running a marathon. It requires focus, commitment, and reliance on God's strength. As we press forward, God enables us to move beyond discouragement and see our difficulties as stepping stones toward spiritual growth and victory.

3.	List steps you can take to strengthen your endurance today.








# **Prayer for Today**

### Devotional: Eternal Glory Through Present Trials

Paul reminds us that these troubles are 'light and momentary' when compared to the eternal glory awaiting us. This eternal perspective empowers endurance, framing suffering as a refining tool God uses for our ultimate good.

God's purposeful work in all things ensures that even hardships contribute to our growth and destiny. Like the psalmist, we can acknowledge that God's testing refines us, despite the weight of the struggles He allows.

Approaching suffering with this mindset helps us embrace growth instead of bitterness. It invites us to cooperate with God's sanctifying work and look ahead to His glorious future promises, which outweigh every hardship endured.

- Philippians 4:13 NIV: "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."







#### Devotional: God's Power Perfected in Our Weakness

**Enduring refining fire requires strength beyond our own.** God's grace is perfectly designed to empower us when we feel weak.

Paul's testimony reveals that limitations and weaknesses open the door for God's power to manifest most clearly. Instead of self-reliance, endurance is sustained through depending on God's strength renewed daily.
