### Your Verse

2 Corinthians 12:9 — "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 40:31 "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."
- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







Day 1: 6 Embracing Strength in Weakness

### Devotional: God's Power Perfected in Our Weakness

**Parenting through foster care often reveals our limits and exposes our vulnerabilities.** There will be moments when exhaustion and weariness threaten to overwhelm us, but God reminds us that His grace is enough. *Paul's words in 2 Corinthians reveal a profound truth: strength is found not by self-reliance but by leaning into God's power in our weakness.* 

This is especially true when love requires sacrifice beyond what we imagined. When a foster child's hurt surfaces or difficult days linger, remember you do not carry this alone. God invites you to rest in His strength, promising renewal when you place your hope in Him. Trusting God transforms your weakness into a platform for His power to display.

As you endure, look to the LORD as your refuge, your help in trouble. Let His strength uplift you for each new day, knowing He equips you to love more deeply than you thought possible.

- Romans 5:3-4 "Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."
- Hebrews 12:1 "Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us."

### Devotional: Joy in Trials Builds Endurance and Hope

**Trials are inevitable in foster parenting, yet they are also a path to spiritual growth.** James challenges us to respond to hardships not with despair but with joy, knowing that perseverance strengthens our faith and shapes our character.

This doesn't mean trials are easy or painless. Instead, it means viewing difficulties through God's eternal perspective—trusting they produce maturity and hope. As you face the challenges of loving children who may have experienced trauma or rejection, remember that your endurance is refining your heart and deepening your capacity to love.

Perseverance is also about endurance over time—a race, not a sprint. Keep running on the path God has set, focusing on loving with patience and grace, believing that He finishes the good work He began in both you and the children entrusted to you.

### Devotional: Enduring Love Reflects Jesus' Sacrifice

Foster parenting calls for love that goes beyond convenience or comfort. Jesus modeled the greatest love by laying down His life for us. Similarly, endurance in parenting means daily choosing sacrificial love — showing patience, forgiveness, and trust even when it's difficult.

Love that perseveres protects and hopes in the face of pain and setbacks. When a child reacts from past wounds or when setbacks occur, your enduring love acts as a healing balm, reflecting Christ's unconditional heart. This love is an offering to God, a living sacrifice that honors Him and transforms lives.

From sleepless nights to emotional storms, your sacrificial love sows seeds of hope and security that will bear fruit for years to come. Remember, each act of kindness and patient endurance is an expression of God's love through you.
