Devotional: Renewed Strength Through Hope in the Lord

Endurance in global missions is impossible without the sustaining presence of God. Isaiah's promise shows us that placing our hope in the Lord renews our strength beyond natural capacity—allowing us to soar, run, and walk tirelessly in our calling.

Devotional: Pressing On With Eternal Perspective

Global missions often require long-term commitment with no immediate results. It's a race that demands focus and perseverance amid setbacks. Remembering the eternal goal—advancing God's kingdom and hearing "Well done"—motivates us to persevere.

Devotional: Equipped to Endure Spiritual Battles

Endurance in global missions requires standing firm against spiritual opposition. Paul's exhortation to put on God's armor reminds us that the mission field is a spiritual battlefield. The enemy seeks to discourage, distract, and derail those called to faithful service.

Equipping ourselves daily with truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the Word of God positions us to stand strong. Missions demand alertness and spiritual courage to resist the schemes of the enemy.

Recognizing the nature of spiritual warfare fosters wisdom and reliance on God's power. Perseverance is built on the foundation of God's armor and ongoing prayer. We do not endure alone but in the strength Christ provides.

Reflect on how spiritual battles have impacted your mission journey and how equipping yourself spiritually can increase your endurance going forward.
