Your Verse

2 Corinthians 12:9 - "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 40:29 "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."
- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







Devotional: God's Grace Empowers Our Weakness

As parents, our doubts often come from feeling inadequate or overwhelmed. The pressure to make perfect choices can be heavy, and in those moments, it's easy to doubt our ability. Paul's words in **2 Corinthians 12:9** remind us that God's grace is enough to carry us. When we feel weak, that's actually when God's strength shines brightest through us.

Prayer for Today

Your Verse

Proverbs 3:5-6 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."
- Psalm 32:8 "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."







Devotional: Lean Fully on God's Guidance

Doubts about parenting often stem from uncertainty about decisions and outcomes. **Proverbs 3:5–6** calls us to trust God wholeheartedly, especially when our understanding falls short. Parenting wisdom isn't just knowledge from books or experience—it's divine guidance available when we seek God's counsel.

James encourages us to ask God for wisdom freely, and He promises to give it generously. As you face daily decisions for your children, cultivate a habit of praying specifically for guidance. Submit your doubts, fears, and plans to Him, trusting His perfect wisdom to direct your steps.

Remember, God's instruction isn't distant or impersonal. Psalm 32:8 reassures us that God watches over us lovingly, ready to counsel us tenderly. When doubts arise, take them to Him first. His wisdom will provide clarity and peace, helping you endure each day with confidence in His plans for your family.

- Hebrews 12:1 "Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us."







Devotional: Hope Grows Through Perseverance

Parenting is a marathon, not a sprint—filled with ongoing challenges and moments that test our endurance. **Romans 5:3–4** shows us how perseverance is formed through trials, transforming character and producing hope. When doubts arise, it's easy to want to give up, but God calls us to persevere.

Day 4: W Finding Peace Amidst Doubt

Devotional: God's Peace Calms Our Anxious Hearts

Doubts about parenting abilities often come with anxiety and fear. **Philippians 4:6-7** offers a powerful remedy: instead of being anxious, bring your concerns to God in prayer with thanksgiving. When we do this, God's peace—beyond human understanding—guards our hearts and minds.

Jesus promised a peace different from what the world offers. In moments of doubt, you can claim that peace, choosing not to be troubled or afraid. Psalm 94 assures us that when anxiety is overwhelming, God's consolation brings joy and calm.

As you face parenting doubts today, pause and take your worries straight to God. Thank Him for His presence and ask Him to fill you with His peace. Allow His comforting Spirit to replace anxiety with a calm endurance that refreshes your spirit.
