#### Devotional: Forgiveness Unlocks Healing and Peace

**Forgiveness is the heartbeat of restoration.** Without forgiveness, wounds fester and distance grows. Ephesians 4:32 calls us to forgive just as Christ forgave us—completely and freely.

Forgiving your spouse doesn't mean minimizing hurt or forgetting pain. Instead, it means releasing bitterness and opening the door to healing. Colossians 3:13 encourages us to bear with one another, showing grace in moments when tough feelings rise.

In restoring marriage, forgiveness breaks cycles of anger and resentment, making space for love to grow. Jesus taught that forgiveness is reciprocal—when we forgive, God forgives us (Matthew 6:14), linking our healing to our willingness to release offenses.

- Proverbs 3:34 He mocks proud mockers but shows favor to the humble and oppressed.

#### Devotional: Embracing Humility to Heal and Restore

# Devotional: God's Strength Empowers Lasting Endurance
