#### Devotional: Finding Strength in the Midst of Trials

#### Devotional: Protecting Your Inner Life as a Leader

**Endurance begins in the heart.** Proverbs instructs leaders to guard their hearts carefully because the condition of the heart influences every decision and action. Spiritual leaders must protect their inner life from bitterness, discouragement, or distraction.

Often, the challenges of leadership can wear down our soul. But God promises closeness in our brokenness and renewal when we feel crushed. This is an invitation to bring our struggles honestly before Him and allow His healing.

Consider what you need to guard in your heart today. Is it fear, pride, or weariness? As you guard your heart, you safeguard your ability to lead with integrity and compassion. Persevere in doing good, knowing God sees and will reward faithful endurance.

#### Prayer for Today



#### Devotional: Humility: The Foundation of Endurance
