## Devotional: Blessed Are Those Who Persevere in Trials

#### Devotional: Renew Your Strength by Hoping in God

Enduring unfairness can drain your energy and spirit, but God offers renewed strength beyond what we can muster on our own. Isaiah's words assure us that placing our hope in the Lord refreshes our inner strength and resilience. When you feel weak or worn out by academic injustice, look to God as your ultimate source of power.

Psalm 46 reminds us that God is always close—a refuge and helper in times of trouble. You don't have to struggle alone. He welcomes you to lean on Him when you feel overwhelmed by unfair situations.

Paul's experience in 2 Corinthians shows that God's grace perfectly sustains us when we are weak. Sometimes we may feel powerless or discouraged, but God's strength shines most clearly when we rely on Him fully.

Today, make it your aim to hope in God and receive His renewing strength amid your challenges at school.

Hebrews 12:1-2 NIV - "Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus... who endured the cross, scorning its shame..."

- Philippians 3:14 "I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."







#### Devotional: Focus on Jesus to Persevere with Purpose

Hebrews encourages us to persevere by focusing on Jesus, the perfect example of endurance through suffering. He endured shame and hardship for a greater purpose, and you too are called to run your race with steady determination.

Philippians inspires us to press on toward God's calling, keeping eyes fixed on the ultimate prize—the life God has prepared. When unfairness threatens to slow you down, remember why you keep going: your faith, your purpose, and God's greater plan.

Today, fix your eyes on Jesus and persevere with a clear purpose, knowing God is with you every step of the way.
