May this plan empower you to shine God's light through your attitude and actions, becoming a witness of hope and steadfastness even in difficult circumstances. #### Your Verse

James 1:12 - Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Romans 5:3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- 1 Peter 2:19 For it is commendable if someone bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because they are conscious of God.







#### Devotional: Choosing Faith Over Frustration At Work

When faced with unfairness at work, it's natural to feel discouraged or defensive. Yet, James reminds us that enduring trials is a path to blessing and strength. *Perseverance is not passive resignation*; it's a deliberate choice to trust God, knowing that He rewards those who remain faithful.

Paul teaches that suffering produces perseverance, molding our character and strengthening faith. And Peter encourages us by affirming that enduring injustice without retaliation honors God. This perspective transforms workplace struggles into a means of spiritual growth.

Reflect: Are you allowing God's promises to sustain you when you experience injustice? Can you see your endurance as a testimony of your love for God? Today, commit to standing firm and trusting that God is working through your trials for your good.

#### Devotional: Finding Purpose Amid Workplace Challenges

### Devotional: Embracing God's Peace in Trials

Workplace injustice can easily stir anxiety and unrest in our hearts. Paul advises us not to be anxious but to bring every concern to God through prayer and thanksgiving. When we do, God's peace, which surpasses all understanding, guards our hearts and minds.

**Peace is a fruit of trusting God** amid difficult circumstances. Isaiah assures us that perfect peace comes when our minds are steadfast on Him. This peace does not depend on changing our situations but on the assurance of God's presence and sovereignty.

Psalm 34 calls us to pursue peace actively. Rather than dwelling on bitterness or resentment, seek God's peace by surrendering control and resting in His love. As you endure unfairness, allow God's peace to calm your spirit and renew your strength for daily faithful living.
