Day 2: Strength in Perseverance

Devotional: Renewed Strength Through Hope in God

Day 3: 🗆 Standing Firm With Faith

Devotional: Equipped to Endure Through Faith

Endurance in career changes requires spiritual armor—faith that protects and equips us in the midst of trials. **Ephesians 6:13** exhorts us to put on God's full armor so that we can stand firm against discouragement, fear, and temptation.

Remember that career transitions often bring testing seasons where our faith is challenged. *James 1:2–4* encourages us to consider these trials as opportunities for growth—perseverance matures our character and faith.

Temptations to give up or become anxious are real. **1 Peter 5:8-9** warns us to be alert because spiritual attacks seek to derail our purpose. But through God's armor—truth, righteousness, faith, and the sword of the Spirit—we can stand unshaken.
