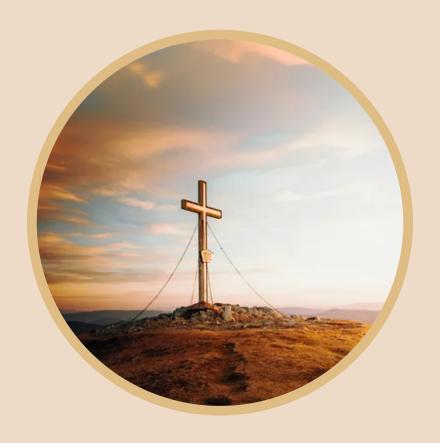
Let this study be a journey toward renewed hope, a deeper understanding of God's love, and the courage to persevere with grace.

#### Your Verse

2 Corinthians 12:9 - "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 40:29 "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."
- Psalm 34:18 "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

# Devotional: Finding Strength in God's Power Amid Weakness

**Emotional wounds can often leave us feeling fragile, exhausted, and vulnerable.** Yet the truth in 2 Corinthians 12:9 reminds us that God's grace is enough—more than enough—to carry us through our moments of weakness. Instead of hiding our pain, we are invited to lean into God's power. He doesn't minimize our suffering; rather, He promises to empower us right in the midst of it.

Isaiah 40:29 assures us that God strengthens the weary, and Psalm 34:18 beautifully says that He is close to the brokenhearted. These promises are a firm foundation when we feel emotionally crushed. When you feel weak and overwhelmed today, remember that God's strength is readily available, and in your weakness, His power shines brightest.

What an incredible comfort it is to know we are never alone in our suffering!

#### Prayer for Today

**Lord, thank You for Your grace that is sufficient in every moment of weakness.** Help me to rely fully on Your strength when my emotional wounds weigh me down. Surround me with Your peace and comfort that only You can provide. Teach me to bring my pain to You without fear, trusting that You are always near the brokenhearted. Renew my spirit and give me endurance to keep walking in hope and healing. *In Jesus' name, Amen.*

















Day 2: B Healing in the Midst of Pain

#### Your Verse

Psalm 147:3 - "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Jeremiah 30:17 "I will restore you to health and heal your wounds," declares the Lord."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."







Day 2: **B** Healing in the Midst of Pain

#### Devotional: God's Promise to Heal Broken Hearts

Emotional wounds are real and painful, but God's promise to heal is equally real and powerful. Psalm 147:3 reminds us that the Lord is actively working to heal our broken hearts and mend our wounds. This healing doesn't always happen overnight, but God's tender care is present every step of the way.

Jeremiah's promise to restore health and heal wounds reinforces that God is not distant or indifferent to our suffering. Instead, He longs to bring restoration. Jesus extends an open invitation in Matthew 11:28 to come to Him when we are weary and burdened. What a beautiful reminder that rest and healing come through relationship with Him.

If you are carrying emotional pain today, take heart—God is near, ready to heal and comfort your soul.

Day 3: (b) Christ's Endurance as Our Example

#### Your Verse

Hebrews 12:2 - "Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 53:3 "He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain."
- 1 Peter 2:21 "To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example."







Day 3: (b) Christ's Endurance as Our Example

#### Devotional: Learning to Endure Like Jesus

Jesus endured intense suffering—physically, emotionally, and spiritually—yet He never wavered in His mission. Hebrews 12:2 encourages us to fix our eyes on Him, understanding that His endurance was fueled by the joy of redeeming mankind. Despite rejection and pain, as noted in Isaiah 53:3, Christ remained steadfast. His endurance was not passive; it was filled with purpose and hope.

1 Peter 2:21 reminds us that Christ's suffering provides a model for us to follow. When we feel battered by emotional wounds, looking to Jesus' example inspires us to endure with faith, knowing that suffering can have meaning and lead to growth.

Today, let Jesus' endurance remind you that you are not alone and that your pain can be transformed through faith and hope.

Day 4: N Finding Peace Through Forgiveness

#### Your Verse

Ephesians 4:31–32 – "Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Colossians 3:13 "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."
- Matthew 6:14 "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you."







Day 4: 🎘 Finding Peace Through Forgiveness

#### Devotional: The Freedom of Forgiveness in Healing

**Emotional wounds often deepen when bitterness and unforgiveness take root.** Ephesians calls us to release anger, bitterness, and malice and instead embrace kindness, compassion, and forgiveness. Forgiving others is not about excusing the hurt but about freeing ourselves from the bondage of resentment.

Colossians and Matthew underscore the importance of forgiving as God has forgiven us. When we forgive, we align ourselves with God's heart, opening the door to peace and healing. While forgiveness can be difficult, it is a vital step toward emotional endurance and restoration.

Ask God to reveal any bitterness you need to release and to help you forgive fully, just as you have been forgiven.

#### Your Verse

Romans 5:3-5 - "Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame..."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- James 1:12 "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life."
- Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."







#### Devotional: Persevering Toward Hope and Renewal

Endurance through emotional wounds is not aimless suffering—it leads to growth, character, and hope. Romans teaches us to glory even in sufferings because they produce perseverance that shapes our character and anchors our hope. This hope is secure because it comes from God, who never abandons us.

James assures us that perseverance brings blessings, and Philippians reminds us that Christ empowers us daily. The journey through emotional healing is ongoing, but with each step, we grow stronger and more hopeful.

Today, embrace the hope that sustains you and look forward with confidence in God's transformative power.

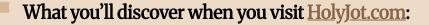




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
