
Enduring Doubts in Your God-Given Calling

Day 1: V Standing Firm in Your Calling

Devotional: Perseverance Under Trial Brings Blessing

Every step taken in faith, even when confused or fearful, moves you closer to the crown of life—a reward for those who love Him and do not give up.

Devotional: Submit Your Path to God's Perfect Guidance

When doubts cloud your understanding of your calling, God's command is clear: *trust Him wholeheartedly*. It's natural to want to lean on our own insight, especially when the future looks uncertain. Yet, the Scripture invites us to surrender our limited perspective and submit every step to the Lord.

Trust is the foundation of endurance. It's what allows us to move forward even when the next step is unseen or when the confirmation we seek doesn't come immediately. God promises that if we trust and submit to Him, He will direct our path—we don't have to walk alone or rely solely on our own reasoning.

Practically, this means choosing faith over fear daily, asking God for guidance, and resting in His timing even if the answers delay. As you face doubts, remember that God's strength is made perfect in weakness and His plans are always for good.
