Your Verse

Devotional: Waiting Builds Perseverance and Hope

Your Verse

Supporting Scriptures

- *Isaiah 43:19 - "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?"*



Devotional: Singleness Is a Time to Flourish

Singleness is a season that offers unique freedom and focus. Paul highlights this advantage in *1 Corinthians 7*, pointing out that the unmarried person can devote undivided attention to the Lord's work without the distractions of additional responsibilities.
