
Equipped for Victory: Applying Ephesians 6 Armor Daily



Day 1: V Standing Firm with the Belt of Truth


Prayer for Today

Devotional: Guarding Your Heart with God's Righteousness

The breastplate protects the heart and vital organs.

Prayer for Today



Prayer for Today



Prayer for Today




Prayer for Today

Devotional: Guarding Your Mind with Hope in Salvation

The helmet protects the head—our thoughts and mind.

Todays's world constantly pushes negative messages, fear, and confusion. When we grasp the full assurance of salvation, it guards our mental wellbeing. It helps us reject lies like shame, hopelessness, or irrelevance.

To put on the helmet: regularly remind yourself of God's saving work, renew your mind through Scripture, and reject ungodly thoughts. Practice mental discipline by focusing on hope and the truth of your eternal security.

3.	Reflect on habits that help you focus on God's promises daily.








Prayer for Today

Devotional: Empowered by Prayer and Spiritual Alertness
