Esther 4:16 - "Go, gather together all the Jews who are in Susa, and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day. I and my attendants will fast as you do. Then I will go to the king, even though it is against the law. And if I perish, I perish."

Supporting Scriptures

- Joel 2:12 "Even now," declares the LORD, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning."
- Psalm 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God."







Day 1: Seeking God with Fasting and Prayer

Devotional: The Power of Prayer and Fasting Before Action

Esther's courage begins with dependence on God. Before taking a dangerous step, she calls for fasting and prayer for three days. This act was more than a physical discipline; it was a spiritual surrender, seeking God's favor and guidance in a dire situation. *Fasting sharpened her focus and prepared her heart* to face uncertainty and risk.

We often rush into our challenges without pausing to seek God's direction. Esther's example urges us to intentionally set aside time to fast and pray, becoming still in God's presence and aligning our hearts with His will. When we do, He strengthens our spirit to act with boldness and wisdom.

As you reflect on this first day, consider what fasting and focused prayer might look like for you. Are you willing to humble yourself before God, asking for His guidance about the fears or decisions weighing you down? Esther's story calls us to trust God deeply when the stakes are highest.

Your Verse

Esther 5:1-2 - "On the third day Esther put on her royal robes and stood in the inner court of the palace, in front of the king's hall. The king was sitting on his royal throne in the hall, facing the entrance. When he saw Queen Esther standing in the court, he was pleased with her and held out the gold scepter that was in his hand. So Esther approached and touched the tip of the scepter."

Supporting Scriptures

- Joshua 1:9 "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."
- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."







Devotional: Bold Steps of Faith Against Fear

After days of preparation, Esther courageously approaches the king, risking her life by stepping into a forbidden room without being summoned. This moment required boldness paired with faith—the knowledge that God was with her as she faced immense danger.

God invites us to step out in faith even when the outcome is uncertain. Like Esther, we may feel vulnerable and exposed, but God's presence empowers us to risk for the sake of His purposes. Our confidence does not come from circumstances, but from trusting in His sovereignty.

Consider how you respond when called to take a bold step. Do you hesitate in fear, or do you move forward trusting God's guidance? Esther's risk was not only personal bravery but also obedience to a divine appointment she could not ignore.

2.	How can trusting God help you overcome fear in difficult situations?
3.	What does it mean to submit your own understanding to God's plan?
