Day 1: 🏠 Finding Joy in God's Presence

#### Your Verse

Psalm 16:11 – "You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Nehemiah 8:10 "The joy of the Lord is your strength."
- John 15:11 "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete."







Day 1: 🏟 Finding Joy in God's Presence

#### Devotional: Joy Flows from God's Presence, Not Circumstances

Joy is not dependent on circumstances, relationships, or status. Psalm 16:11 reminds us that joy comes from God's presence and the eternal pleasures found in Him. When you feel the weight of loneliness or the pressure of singleness, remember that God offers a joy that is full and lasting.

Often, singleness can feel like a void waiting to be filled, but God invites you to fill that space with Himself first. Nehemiah 8:10 encourages us to find strength in the joy that comes from the Lord — a joy that sustains and empowers us beyond what the world offers.

This joy is a gift and a sign of God's intimate relationship with you. Through Jesus, who desires your joy to be complete (John 15:11), you can experience a fullness that is not dependent on a partner but on the God who loves you unconditionally.

Today, embrace the reality that you are deeply loved and cherished. Let God's presence be your joy and strength, and watch how this transforms your experience of singleness from one of want to one of abundance.

- Romans 12:11 "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord."
- Colossians 3:23 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."







#### Devotional: Singleness: A Season to Serve with Zeal

Singleness offers a unique freedom to serve God fully and passionately. Paul's words in 1 Corinthians 7:32 highlight the privilege of being able to focus entirely on the Lord's affairs without divided interests or distractions.

When you're single, you have an opportunity to dedicate your energy, time, and gifts wholeheartedly to God's purposes. Romans 12:11 encourages believers to maintain zeal and spiritual fervor — a call that applies strongly to single life where you can serve in ways others may find challenging to pursue.

Serving God wholeheartedly brings fulfillment and joy beyond what circumstances can dictate. Colossians 3:23 reminds us to work as though serving God directly, which is a powerful reminder that your efforts, even in small acts of service, matter greatly to Him.

Today, reflect on how singleness positions you to make an impact for God's kingdom. Rather than seeing it as lack, view it as opportunity to pour your heart into ministry, relationships, and causes God places before you.

Are there areas in your life where you feel God is calling you to greater
commitment and zeal?
How can you maintain motivation to serve wholeheartedly even when feeling isolated or overlooked?

	Write a plan for how you can use your season of singleness to grow in ministry.
3.	Reflect on how serving God faithfully brings purpose to your daily life.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 37:7 "Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him."
- Isaiah 40:31 "Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength."







# Devotional: Learning Contentment While Waiting on God

Waiting can be difficult, especially when longing for companionship or life changes. However, Paul's testimony in Philippians 4:11–13 offers a powerful example of contentment regardless of circumstances. His secret lies in the strength he receives from Christ.

As a single believer, you may wrestle with impatience or feelings of incompleteness. Psalm 37:7 gently reminds you to be still and wait patiently for the Lord, trusting His timing and wisdom.

Hope in the Lord brings renewal and strength to persevere. Isaiah 40:31 assures that those who place their hope in God will find their strength renewed like eagles soaring. This promise invites you to view waiting not as inactivity but as an active posture of trust.

Today, focus on cultivating contentment by relying on Christ's power. Let waiting be a season of spiritual growth and deepening faith rather than frustration or anxiety.

3.	Write a prayer asking God to help you grow in contentment and trust.







#### Prayer for Today

When feelings of loneliness or impatience come, remind me of Your faithfulness and love. Renew my hope daily and keep my heart fixed on Your promises. #### Your Verse

Ephesians 1:4-5 - "He chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight... predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- 1 John 3:1 "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!"
- Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me."







Day 4: 🚨 Identity Rooted in God's Love

#### Devotional: Embracing Your God-Given Identity

Your identity is firmly rooted in God's love and purpose, not your relationship status. Ephesians 1:4–5 reveals that God chose and adopted you before the world began — you are His beloved child, holy and blameless.

In moments when singleness feels isolating or defining, it is vital to remember 1 John 3:1's encouragement: you are lavished with God's immense love and called His child. This identity surpasses any human labels or expectations.

Because Christ lives in you (Galatians 2:20), your true worth comes from Him. Embracing this truth frees you from the pressure of worldly definitions and opens the door to abundant joy and confidence in your daily walk.

Today, meditate on your heaven-sent identity. Let God's love reshape how you view yourself and empower you to live boldly as His chosen one.

#### Devotional: Choose Joy and Embrace God's Gift Today

Ecclesiastes 3:12–13 encourages us to find happiness and satisfaction as gifts from God, reminding us that joy is accessible today, not only in the future.
