By the end of this journey, you may gain a clearer perspective about the evidence and reality of God's existence, the hope found in Him, and the







invitation to know Him personally. Let these three weeks be a time of discovery, faith, and spiritual awakening.

Devotional: Creation Reveals the Creator's Existence

God's existence is first revealed through creation. The opening verse of the Bible makes a profound claim: God is the Creator of all things. When you look at the universe—the vastness of galaxies, the complexity of life on Earth—it points to a deliberate and powerful Designer. Creation does not come from chaos or chance alone.

Take time today to consider the evidence around you. The order in nature, the precision of natural laws, and the beauty in life are signs pointing toward God's hand. The psalmist captures this well, describing how the heavens loudly proclaim God's glory without words.

Reflect on how this connects to your view of whether God exists. Genesis invites us to start with the assumption of a Creator who brings about everything that is, without whom nothing would exist.

Devotional: God's Qualities Are Visible in Creation

God's existence is not hidden but evident through His creation. Romans teaches us that His power and divine nature are clearly perceived by observing the world. This means that the natural world serves as a testimony to something beyond itself.

Even when people deny God, the Bible calls this foolishness because the evidence is visible. When you observe nature or the intricacies of life, you are seeing the fingerprints of God. Job reminds us that every living being reflects the life-giving power of God.

Think about this evidence today and consider your response. Does your observation of creation inspire faith or doubt? What keeps you from fully embracing God's reality?

Devotional: Conscience Points to a Moral Creator

Beyond physical creation, God reveals Himself in our inner moral compass.

Paul explains that even those who do not know God's law instinctively understand right and wrong through their conscience. This internal witness points to a Creator who has embedded His moral law within humanity.

Your conscience is not accidental but a reflection of God's nature. It helps distinguish right from wrong and shows that humans are created with purpose and an innate sense of accountability to God. Solomon writes that God places eternity in our hearts, meaning we carry an awareness beyond the present life.

Consider today how your conscience has guided you. What does this say about God's existence and His design for humanity?

The Bible claims divine origin, making it unique among all writings. As believers seek evidence of God's existence, the Scriptures themselves stand as a key pillar of that evidence. 2 Timothy reminds us that all Scripture is inspired by God—breathed out from Him.

This indicates God's direct involvement in the Bible's formation. The Bible not only teaches about God but is living and powerful, able to transform hearts. It provides guidance and clarity for those questioning God's reality.

Reflect today on the Bible's reliability and authority. When you read it, how does it impact your awareness of God? Do you approach Scripture as a trustworthy source on God's existence?

Miracles serve a dual purpose: they reveal God's glory and invite faith in Him. They break through ordinary life and declare God's active presence in history. Jesus' first miracle turned water into wine, confirming His authority and identity, inspiring His followers' faith.

Reflect on miracles you have heard about or witnessed. How do they influence your belief in God? Consider how God might be working in your life in ways beyond human understanding.
