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Introduction

You will meet the woman who broke the norms to honor Jesus with her precious ointment, highlighting the heart behind worship. From her story, we learn about the nature of true devotion—one that risks reputation, resources, and comfort for the sake of honoring Jesus.

Across seven days, we will explore the deep significance of this story in the light of other Gospel accounts, helping us see how extravagant love is a response to Christ's saving grace. We will reflect on the difference between costless admiration and costly devotion and examine how Jesus' grace transforms our lives to worship Him with abandon.

Whether you are new to faith or seeking renewed passion in your walk with Christ, this study invites you to meditate on what it means to pour out your love generously and authentically. May these reflections inspire you to an







extravagant love and inspire costly devotion to the Savior who gave everything for you. \triangle















Your Verse

Mark 14:3 – "While he was in Bethany, reclining at the table in the home of Simon the Leper, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, made of pure nard. She broke the jar and poured the perfume on his head."

Supporting Scriptures

- Luke 7:37 "A woman in that town who lived a sinful life learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an alabaster jar of perfume."
- John 12:3 "Then Mary took about a pint of pure nard, an expensive perfume; she poured it on Jesus' feet and wiped his feet with her hair."







Devotional: Breaking the Jar: Worship That Costs Everything

The woman's act of breaking the alabaster jar was both shocking and significant. In the ancient world, perfume of such value represented a considerable investment, something preserved and guarded. Yet, this woman shattered the jar, symbolizing her complete surrender and outrageous love poured out for Jesus. Her devotion was not measured by caution but by the extravagant love she expressed, regardless of cost or social judgment.

Throughout Scripture, worship is portrayed as a gift of our hearts, often requiring boldness and sacrifice. The woman's action challenges us to consider what we hold back in our own worship and how fear or social expectations might restrain our expression of love toward God.

Jesus honored her act, affirming that such devotion prepares Him for His coming death. Her extravagant love was not wasted but treasured, revealing the kind of devotion that reflects a deep understanding of who Jesus is.

As you begin this study, ask yourself: How willing am I to break open my own alabaster jar? What does extravagant love in worship look like in my daily life?

Devotional: Not Wasteful, But Worshipful: Gifts That Honor Jesus

The perfume was costly—an extravagant gift that shocked the onlookers.

Their indignation reveals how human perspectives often measure love and devotion by practicality or social norms. Yet, Jesus challenges that viewpoint, affirming the deeper meaning behind the woman's actions.

The perfume symbolized preparation for Jesus' impending death—a prophetic act of honoring Him as the Messiah who would give His life as a sacrifice. This act was not wasteful but deeply purposeful.

This story invites us to consider how our gifts, time, and resources can be dedicated fully to God's purposes. Are we willing to offer what others may see as "too much" or "wasteful" if it honors Jesus? The perfume's fragrance lingered, just like the lasting impact of genuine devotion on Jesus' heart.

Today, reflect on how you view generosity. Is your love and giving measured by worldly standards or by the heart of worship expressed toward Jesus?

Devotional: Standing Firm in Devotion Amid Criticism

The woman's costly devotion was met with criticism and harsh judgment: people questioned her motives and even rebuked her, reflecting the tension between cultural expectations and heartfelt worship.

Jesus often faced criticism for associating with those deemed outcasts or sinners, yet His compassion and recognition of genuine love never wavered. This story reminds us that choosing to love extravagantly may invite misunderstandings or condemnation from others.

Are we prepared to face opposition when our actions reflect true devotion? Does the fear of criticism hold us back from expressing love boldly? Jesus' defense of the woman shows us that He values the intent and heart more than others' opinions. Our worship should be centered on His acceptance, not human approval.

Consider how Jesus intercedes for those loving Him authentically, and let that encourage you to pursue devotion without fear.

Devotional: Worship That Joins Christ's Sacrifice

Jesus acknowledged the woman's act as preparation for His burial, pointing to the sorrowful purpose of His imminent crucifixion. Her extravagant love was not only an expression of worship but a prophetic participation in Jesus' sacrifice.

This truth deepens our understanding of devotion: it is not detached from the realities of suffering and self-giving. Worship often intersects with surrender to God's redemptive plan, which includes embracing both joy and sacrifice.

How might worship prepare us for the trials ahead? How does recognizing Jesus' sacrifice encourage us to offer our best to Him? The woman's perfume becomes a symbol of costly love that anticipates Jesus' death and honors His mission.

As we walk in worship, may we be reminded that our devotion can participate in the greater story of redemption through Christ's death and resurrection.
