Welcome to this 7-day Bible study plan focusing on the incredible story of Jesus calming the storm while He slept. - Psalm 107:29 "He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed."
- Isaiah 43:2 "When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you."







Day 1: Car The Storm Arises

Devotional: Trusting Jesus Amid Life's Unexpected Storms

Storms come unexpectedly, often testing our sense of security and shaking our peace. In Mark 4:37–38, the disciples encounter a furious squall that threatens to overwhelm their boat. In fear and desperation, they wake Jesus, not understanding why He rests amid such peril. This moment reminds us that life's storms can be sudden, intense, and frightening.

But notice Jesus' response: He sleeps, demonstrating profound trust and authority over the elements. While the disciples panic, Jesus is at peace, showing that His rest and confidence stem from His identity as the Son of God.

The Psalmist celebrates God's power to "still the storm," and Isaiah reminds us that God is with us even in the raging waters. This day invites us to reflect on our perspective in life's storms: do we panic, or do we seek the peace that only Jesus provides?

As you begin this study, consider the storms you face and how you respond to them. Let's open our hearts to learn from Jesus, so we might find his peace in every turmoil.

Prayer for Today

Teach me to find rest in Your peace and to remember that You are always in control. Strengthen my faith so I can stop panicking and start trusting Your power and love. Guard my heart against fear and fill me with Your calming presence. *Thank You for being my refuge and strength.*

Your Verse

Mark 4:39 – "He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, 'Quiet! Be still!' Then the wind died down and it was completely calm."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God."
- John 14:27 "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you."







Devotional: Calling on Jesus: Finding Peace in His Power

The power of Jesus over the storm reveals His divine authority. When the disciples awoke Jesus and pleaded for help, He did not panic or struggle. Instead, He calmly rebuked the wind and spoke peace to the raging waves, instantly calming the sea.

This shows us that Jesus has authority over nature, our fears, and the chaos around us. The Psalmist's call to "be still" challenges us to cease striving and recognize God's sovereign control, even when situations seem uncontrollable.

Jesus' gift of peace (John 14:27) is more than the absence of trouble; it is a deep, abiding calm rooted in His presence. When we wake Jesus in our hearts through prayer and faith, He responds, speaking peace into our lives and silencing the storms.

Today, consider how you can intentionally seek Jesus' peace amid your own turmoil by calling out to Him in faith, trusting His authority to bring calm where there is chaos.

1.	What does Jesus' command over the storm teach you about His divine authority?
2.	In what ways can you 'wake' Jesus through your prayers during difficult times?
3.	How does knowing Jesus gives peace impact your reaction to life's troubles?

1.	Write a prayer asking Jesus to calm your current fears or anxieties.
2.	Reflect on areas in your life where you need to trust Jesus' authority more.
	Journal how you can cultivate a habit of turning to Jesus first in times of trouble.

Dear Jesus, thank You for Your power to command peace over every storm in my life. Help me to turn to You quickly when fears and trials arise. Teach me to trust Your authority and rest in Your calming presence. May Your peace fill my heart and silence every worry, so I may walk boldly in faith. I choose today to seek You first and wake You with my prayers. *Thank You for Your unfailing love and power.*

Your Verse

Mark 4:40 – "He said to his disciples, 'Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

Supporting Scriptures

- Hebrews 11:1 "Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."
- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control."







Devotional: Choosing Faith Over Fear in Life's Storms

Fear often paralyzes us and clouds our judgment during storms. Jesus' question to His disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" cuts to the core of how our hearts respond to crises.

Faith is the key that unlocks peace despite uncertainty. It is not blind optimism but a confident trust in God's character and promises, even when we cannot see the outcome.

Hebrews defines faith as assurance about what we do not see — a foundation that stabilizes us amid life's unpredictable storms. God equips us with a spirit of power, love, and self-control, enabling us to resist fear.

Today challenges you to evaluate your fear and faith balance. Are you trusting God's presence and power more than your own understanding or worries? Jesus lovingly calls us out of fear and into faith so that we may experience His peace fully.

1.	When do you find fear creeping into your heart the most?
2.	How can you strengthen your faith during difficult seasons?
3.	What truths about God help you replace fear with confidence?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Describe a situation where fear hindered your faith and how you overcame it.
2.	List promises from God's Word that encourage you to trust Him.
3.	Reflect on how God's Spirit helps you respond to fear today.







Prayer for Today

Heavenly Father, help me to recognize fear and not let it rule my heart. Strengthen my faith so it can rise above every worry and doubt. Remind me that You have given me power, love, and self-control. Fill me with Your courage and peace as I lean on Your promises. Teach me to trust You more deeply each day and to walk confidently even when the way is unclear. *Thank You for loving me and walking through every storm with me.*

Devotional: Embracing God's Ever-Present Help in Trouble

One of the greatest comforts we can cling to is the presence of God with us in every storm. The psalmist declares fearless confidence even in the darkest valleys because God is by his side.

Jesus promises His ongoing presence to every believer, assuring that we are never alone in our trials. Isaiah's words reinforce that God strengthens and helps us, equipping us to face challenges.

When we truly believe God is with us—the Shepherd guiding and protecting—we can walk through storms without being overwhelmed by fear. Knowing Jesus is with us brings peace and courage that nothing else can offer.

Today, meditate on God's faithful presence and let it strengthen your heart as you face whatever storms may come.

1.	How does knowing God is always with you impact your fear?
2.	Can you recall times you experienced God's presence during hardship?
3.	What practical ways can you remind yourself of God's nearness daily?

Prayer for Today

Gracious God, thank You for never leaving me alone in life's storms. Help me to trust deeply that You walk beside me every step, strengthening and guiding me. When darkness surrounds me, remind me of Your light and love. Fill my heart with courage, knowing You are my refuge and shield. May I lean on Your presence and find hope that sustains me through every trial. *I am grateful that You are with me always.*

- Romans 8:28 "In all things God works for the good of those who love him."







Devotional: Walking Forward in God's Faithfulness and Grace
