Day 1: **B** Trusting God in Transitions

Devotional: Trust God Fully in Uncertain Times

During a career change, uncertainty can easily cloud your mind. Proverbs 3:5-6 urges us to **trust God wholeheartedly**, especially when our own understanding feels insufficient. This trust isn't passive; it's an active surrender of control and a commitment to seek God's guidance in every decision.

Like many women in the Bible who faced uncertain futures—like Ruth stepping into a new land, or Esther facing a daunting calling—you are invited to release anxiety and lean into God's steadfast presence. Devotional: God's Unique Purpose for You

When transitioning careers, it's easy to question your worth or purpose. Yet, Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us God already has a plan filled with hope for your life. You are **fearfully and wonderfully made**—not by your job title but by the Creator's hands with intentional design.

Women like Deborah, a leader and judge, illustrate how God calls each of us uniquely to serve His kingdom in different seasons and roles. Bearing this in mind, discernment isn't just about finding a job; it's about discovering how God's purpose unfolds through your gifts, passions, and experiences.

As you seek that purpose, invite the Holy Spirit to illuminate areas where your talents align with God's plans. Embracing God's purpose for you means stepping forward with courage, knowing that He goes before you and equips you for every good work.

Day 3: 😂 Seeking God's Wisdom Daily

Devotional: Ask God Daily for Wisdom and Guidance

Discerning your next step after a career change requires wisdom—divine insight that transcends mere human knowledge. James 1:5 encourages us to ask God for wisdom openly, trusting He will provide without reproach.

Like Anna, the prophetess who devoted herself to worship and prayer, we too are called to seek God consistently, trusting that His word will illuminate the path ahead. Wisdom often comes through quiet moments of prayer, meditation on Scripture, and receptivity to the Holy Spirit's guidance.

This day is a reminder to cultivate a habit of seeking God's wisdom daily, recognizing that it fuels understanding and discernment far beyond what experience alone can offer. When you pause, pray, and read Scripture, your path becomes clearer, strength grows, and fears diminish.

Your Verse

Joshua 1:9 - "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."
- Psalm 27:1 "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear?"







Devotional: Step Forward with God-Given Courage

Taking the first step into the unknown can be daunting. God's command through Joshua 1:9 to **be strong and courageous** echoes powerfully for women embarking on new vocational paths. Courage doesn't mean absence of fear but choosing faith over fear.

Like Esther who bravely approached the king to save her people, you too are called to step forward with confidence, knowing God's presence goes with you. The Holy Spirit empowers us with love, strength, and self-control—not timidity.

Remember that courage is cultivated through dependence on God, prayer, and community support. When discouragement whispers, recall God's promise: He will be with you wherever you go. Your journey is blessed, and your faith will lead you to new opportunities.

Supporting Scriptures

- John 14:27 "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you."
- Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."







Day 5: 🚨 Finding Peace Amid Change

Devotional: Experience God's Peace Amid Anxiety

Change can stir anxiety, especially in the midst of career transitions. Philippians 4:6–7 offers a divine prescription: bring your concerns to God through prayer and thanksgiving. This act of trust invites His peace to guard your heart and mind.

Women like Mary, who trusted God's word even when it meant uncertainty, show us how peace blooms when faith overcomes worry. God's peace transcends human understanding; it is a calm assurance rooted in His sovereign love.

Today, focus on exchanging anxious thoughts for prayerful conversation with God. Gratitude for His past faithfulness opens the door for peace to protect your spirit. Embrace this peace as a vital companion in discerning your next move.

Reflect on women like Hannah, whose faithfulness and prayer in difficult times led to God's abundant blessings. Celebrating God's past faithfulness cultivates trust for what lies ahead.

As you journal your journey, take time to acknowledge and thank God for the ways He has sustained you. These testimonies are powerful anchors, reminding you that the God guiding you now has never abandoned you.
